

Little Ondine Natural Nail Polish Info

To get the best wear out of the Little Ondine polishes:

- Apply before bed so they have the best chance of curing and so that your hands do not come into contact with any water.
- Buff your nails, wipe your nail beds with rubbing alcohol to remove oils for better adhesion, apply before bed, and don't wet your hands.
- Use the Base + Top coat
- Cap your tips when you're applying them; simply run the brush side to side on the free edge of the nail to seal it in.

Wear time:

- You can get over a month of wear on your toes (but definitely need to soak them in warm water for 10-15 minutes before peeling them off!)
- They'll last about 3 days or more on fingers, depending on how often you're exposing your hands to water. Some people can get anywhere from 3-7 days of wear.

To remove the polish:

- Simply peel the polish off from side to side vs. front to back (if you can help it).
- If you've had the polish on your hands for a few days and they're difficult to peel, you'll need to soak them in warm water before removing them. Use a metal cuticle pusher or an orange stick to lift the polish off the nail before you peel it off. If you don't soak your nails and peel them off, you may notice that the polish will "peel" some of your nail bed with it. Obviously, it won't peel the nail bed as badly as if you peeled off gel polish from your nails, but if you have weak or brittle nails, it's highly recommend to soak them before peeling it off to minimize nail dryness.
- If the polish is being very stubborn, you can use acetone and a cotton pad for easy removal.
- The polishes are fast-drying, so if you mess up or don't like the colour, you can run your freshly painted fingers (within 5 mins of painting them) under a faucet, and the colour will rinse off. This will not happen after you've had them on your hands for a few days.
- If one nail starts to peel off, you can redo that one nail.

If the polish starts to thicken:

- Add a few drops of water into the bottle, shake the bottle, and voila! Thinned out polish!
- The polish on the opening of the bottle may congeal from time to time; simply pull it off. This will not affect the quality of the polish.
