

## How to Change the Hysteresis Setting on Thermotec Inverter Heat Pumps

## **Overview**

On the Thermotec Inverter heat pumps, the default variance between the temperature set point and when the heat pump turns on and off is +/- 1c

This means the temperature will go 1c above and below the set point

In some applications, eg koi ponds more accurate temperature control is required.

This guide shows you how to change the hysteresis to +/- 0.5c

le if the desired temperature is set to 15c, the heat pump will turn on when the temperature falls to 14.5c and turn off when it reaches 15.5c

## **Procedure**

At the home screen, press on the cog icon




Enter the access code of 66



Press the right button to scroll through the parameters to parameter R04





Click on the value for R04 which is normally on 1

## Change the value from 1 to 0.5

Repeat for parameter **R12** and also change it from 1 to 0.5
