

Bloodborne Pathogens for General Industry Course Outline-Online

Overview:

This course meets the training requirements for OSHA Standard (29 CFR 1910.1030). The purpose of this course is to ensure awareness and promote safety among employees who may be exposed to bloodborne pathogens. The objective is to ensure that employees operate in the safest possible manner in situations where contact with potentially infectious materials is likely.

Who should take this course?

With increase of the likelihood of transmission of bloodborne diseases in today's workplace many positions that would have never given a thought to taking this type of training are now required. Bloodborne Pathogens training is required for employees such as housekeepers, lab tech, nurses, physicians, maintenance personnel or any other employee who may come in contact with infectious materials, blood or bloodborne diseases.
