

Chemical Safety Course Outline-Online

Course Overview:

This module provides the employee with an overview of the requirements of OSHA's Hazard Communication Standard (29 CFR §1910.1200) and chemical safety information covered under the OSHA Laboratory Safety Standard (29 CFR §1910.1450). The employee will learn the basic issues that will serve as a foundation for job-specific chemical safety that should be provided by the worker's supervisor.
