

# HINTON MOTORCYCLE ASSOCIATION GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT

## 1. GATE IS NOT TO BE SHUT OR LOCKED WHILE IN USE FOR EMERGENCY PURPOSES AND EMT CREWS

2. All riders must ride at their own risk. No riding alone. Minimum of 2 people present at track. Always do a slow "warm up" lap to ensure the track is in decent shape and clear to ride.
3. Helmet, boots (no runners/sandals) and protective eye wear **MUST** be worn while riding.
4. No changing the track/creating shortcuts. No riding in the opposite direction.
5. Pets must be leashed at ALL times.
6. No overnight camping allowed unless during a special event
7. No using the track while impaired by drugs or alcohol.
8. All members are required to show proper etiquette to other members, spectators or any other individuals present while using track. Riders should follow the 15-minute rule when there are both younger/less experienced riders and more advanced riders wanting to use the larger track. (Rotate every 15-min)
9. **ALL** riders **MUST** have a current HMA membership.
10. HMA stickers **MUST** be put on either the left front fork or bottom of your helmet. The sticker needs to be visible for our volunteers to see whether a rider is a member or not. Should a sticker happen to come off, you will be required to return it or any portion of it to obtain a new sticker otherwise there will be a \$5 charge for a new sticker. This is to ensure stickers are not being given out to anyone who has not paid for a membership.
11. The membership is for the individual not the bike. Therefore, you are not permitted to loan your bike to a non-member to ride the track.
12. **All guests/day pass holders who intend to ride the track must be accompanied by a full member and have filled out and signed a waiver form.**
13. All members who allow guests to ride without filling out a waiver risk losing their own membership for the season. Members are responsible for their guests.
14. A key code for the gate and stickers will be provided upon membership purchase. Should the track be closed for any reason, this code will be changed to avoid accidental use.
15. **No** littering-please use the dumpsters and bins provided or take your garbage with you.
17. Absolutely **NO RIDING** while grooming is in progress.
18. Grab a rake or shovel from time to time and help keep the track maintained, empty garbage bins if you see them overflowing, pick rocks when you have a few minutes between rides. This will help keep the track in better overall condition.
19. To ensure your safety, please do a slow first lap of the track to ensure there are no major issues. Any areas needing attention should be reported to a board member right away.
20. Report observed infractions to a HMA volunteer/board member.

**These rules have been put in place for everyone's safety. Our volunteers are working very hard to keep our track in good condition and an enjoyable place to ride. Let's have a great riding season!**
