“French Bar is rooted in the spirit of the California Gold Rush, and our wines pay homage to the men and women who followed promises of fortune and freedom into the untamed west. We hand-select our fruit from sustainably grown vineyards on our ranch in the eastern foothills of California’s Sierra Mountains. The unique topography and rocky soils challenge the vines, just as they challenged the pioneers, and the result is beautifully balanced fruit with exceptional color and flavor.”

Our 2016 release of **French Bar Petite Sirah** brings together fruit from our family’s Rock Ridge Vineyard site and is shaped under the care of winemaker Ted Coleman, and produced at our winery in Sonoma County. French Bar wines are sustainably farmed and subject to the “Lodi Rules” for sustainable certified green winegrowing standards.

Wine Notes

A brilliant dark purple color unfolds into flavors of raspberry, blueberry and black cherry. Cassis, vanilla, and roasted coffee add to the intensity of the wine. Opulent and generous, it manages to deliver elegant tannin and a long lingering finish.
