C2F: move next ST to CN & hold in front, K1, K1 from CN

C4F: move next 2 STS to CN & hold in front, K2, K2 from CN

C6F: move next 3 STS to CN & hold in front, K3, K3 from CN

CB: cable back

CC: contrasting color

CCD: centered double decrease

CF: cable forward

CN: cable needle

CO: cast on See Video

CONT: continue

DEC: decrease

P1B: purl 1 ST in the row below

SSP: slip 2 STS, purl the 2 slipped STS together through back loop (decrease 1 ST)

STST: stockinette stitch

TBL: through the back loop

TOG: together

YO: yarn over

W&T: wrap and turn

WS: wrong side

WYIB: with yarn in back

WYIF: with yarn in front
