- 3. Plug the video plug on the adapter cable into the yellow Video In socket on your TV/monitor.
- 4. Plug the audio jack into either audio socket (red or white) on your TV/monitor.
- 5. Plug the power supply's jack into the power socket on the adapter cable.
- 6. Plug the power supply into any 120V AC outlet.
