BACKGROUND:

15. **Delivery**

- 15.1 CBC Computer Systems Ltd will notify you by way of email when your goods are to be dispatched to you. The message will contain details of estimated delivery times in addition to any reasons for a delay in the delivery of the Goods purchased by you.

16. Returns Policy
