

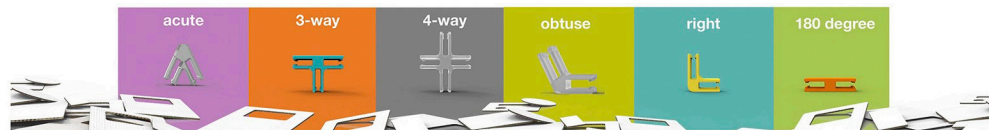
The Architect's Tools

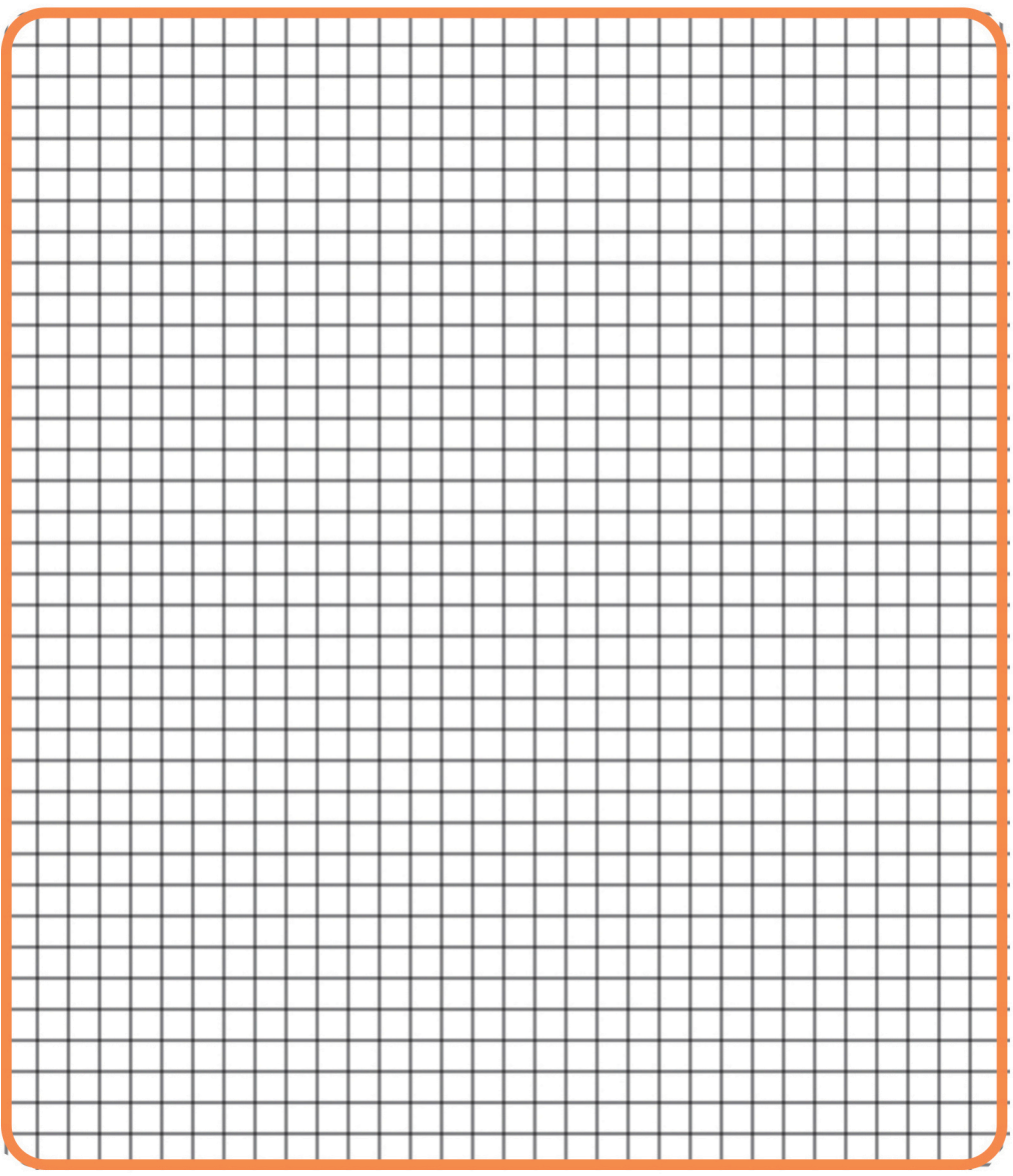

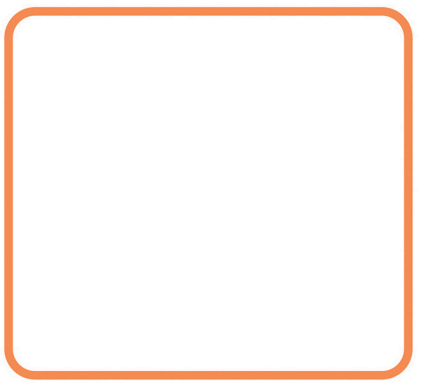

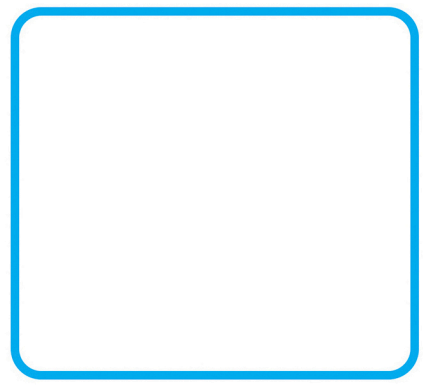
