



Join us for a Meat & Greet

Overview:

At the farmers market, we are frequently asked questions such as: “What exactly *is* a CSA?”, “What’s inside those brown bags?”, or “How much meat is in a quarter-beef?” In an effort to answer these questions and more, we are excited to offer “Meat and Greet” gatherings—a time where current (or prospective) CSA members partner with us to host a gathering, inviting their family, friends, neighbors, and others that would be interested in learning more about our CSA program or bulk order options.. Since no party is complete without food, we will work with hosts to plan a menu and provide the necessary meats, poultry, and/or eggs to prepare refreshments for your guests to enjoy (see ideas below). As a ‘thank you’ for helping us share more about our farm with others, we will provide each gathering with a few door prizes and the host will earn a \$40 credit for each person/family signing up for our CSA. Farm staff are available to help hosts plan, prep, and carry-out the gathering, providing as much (or as little) assistance as needed.

Sample Gathering Outline:

Welcome/introductions • Overview of our farm • Overview of our CSA and Bulk orders • Refreshments • Wrap-Up (Questions/Answers, Order Placement, Door Prizes, etc.)

Refreshment Ideas:

- Breakfast Casserole featuring eggs, bacon, or sausage
- Taco Bar featuring chorizo, ground beef, and pork roast (for carnitas)
- Lasagna, spaghetti, or pizza featuring Italian sausage, ground beef, or ground pork
- Soup Sampler featuring a whole chicken (chicken and noodle), ham steak (split pea), and ground beef (chili)
- Host’s Choice: If you have a favorite dish that you would like to make and serve to your guests, let us know and we will try our best to accommodate your request
