Tipping Restraint Hardware







Insert 3 wooden dowels (A) into the holes, as shown in the diagram.









Insert 4 wooden dowels (A) into the holes, as shown in the diagram.











Attach part 15 on to parts 13 and 6, with 3 bolts (B) using 1 Allen wrench (G).















Insert 6 wooden dowels (A) into the holes, as shown in the diagram.










Attach 2 corner plate (E) on the part 4, with 2 screws (D) using Phillips Screwdriver.






Insert part 4 between parts 5.

Insert 4 wooden dowels (A) into the holes, as shown in the diagram.




Attach 2 screws (D) on to corner plate and parts 5, using 1 Phillips Screwdriver.



















2 3/4" Bolt


- 1 Attach the Plastic Bracket (Y) on the wall stud with 2 screws (X), using 1 Phillips Screwdriver.
- 2 Attach the Plastic Bracket (Y) on the bookcase with 2 screws (Z), using 1 Phillips Screwdriver.



Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip over. To help prevent tip over:


- * Place heaviest items in the lowest drawers.

Tipping Restraint Instructions


Step 1


- * This tip restraint must be attached to a Wall Stud using the 2" screw (X) enclosed.
- * When properly installed, this hardware can provide protection against the unexpected tipping of furniture.
- * Attach one of the mounting brackets (Y) securely to the back top edge of the unit using the short screw (Z).
- * Place the other bracket on the wall over a wall stud and 2 inches below the mounting bracket secured to the back of your unit. Attach to the wall stud using the 2" screw (X) provided, through the bracket hole.
- * Place the unit to the bracket on the back edge of unit is in line with the bracket on the wall.



- * Lace the end of the nylon restraint strap (W) through each bracket. Bring both ends together and slide the beaded end of the strap through the keyhole shaped slot on the other end. Pull down on the beaded end until it snap-locks into the keyhole.
- * Check to make sure the strap is securely laced and locked to the brackets.

MAINTENANCE:

- Our furniture is designed to be low maintenance, however misuse, irregular use, or improper assembly can result in product malfunction. Regularly check the stability. If pieces feel loose or wobbly tighten all screws immediately.
- To store, review Assembly Instructions and reverse the steps to disassemble.
- Use only provided hardware to assemble and maintain assembly.

CARE:

- To clean use a soft, lint free rag similar to a cloth diaper and wipe away dust regularly.
 If necessary dampen cloth slightly with warm water and gently rub away spots. Dry thoroughly.
 - · Do not use a bleach solution.
 - Do not submerse or allow to lie in standing water.
 - Do not use a sponge or harsh abrasive.
 - Do not use all purpose cleaners or harsh detergents.
 - Do not use Pine Oil cleaners or abrasive household cleaners.
 - · Do not use heat or hot water.

This product has been carefully crafted of MDF, solid pine wood and/or pine veneers. These materials derive from plantations, a renewable and well managed forest, therefore, not endangering the environment. Due to the natural variances in the graining of wood, you may notice subtle differences in the shading and tone of the color stain, warp, holes, wood knots and also small cracks.
