Headboard panels

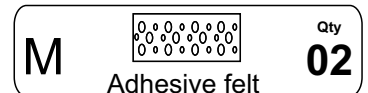
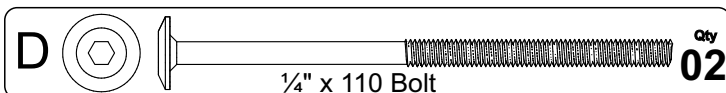
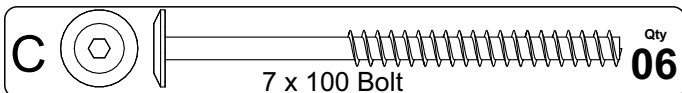
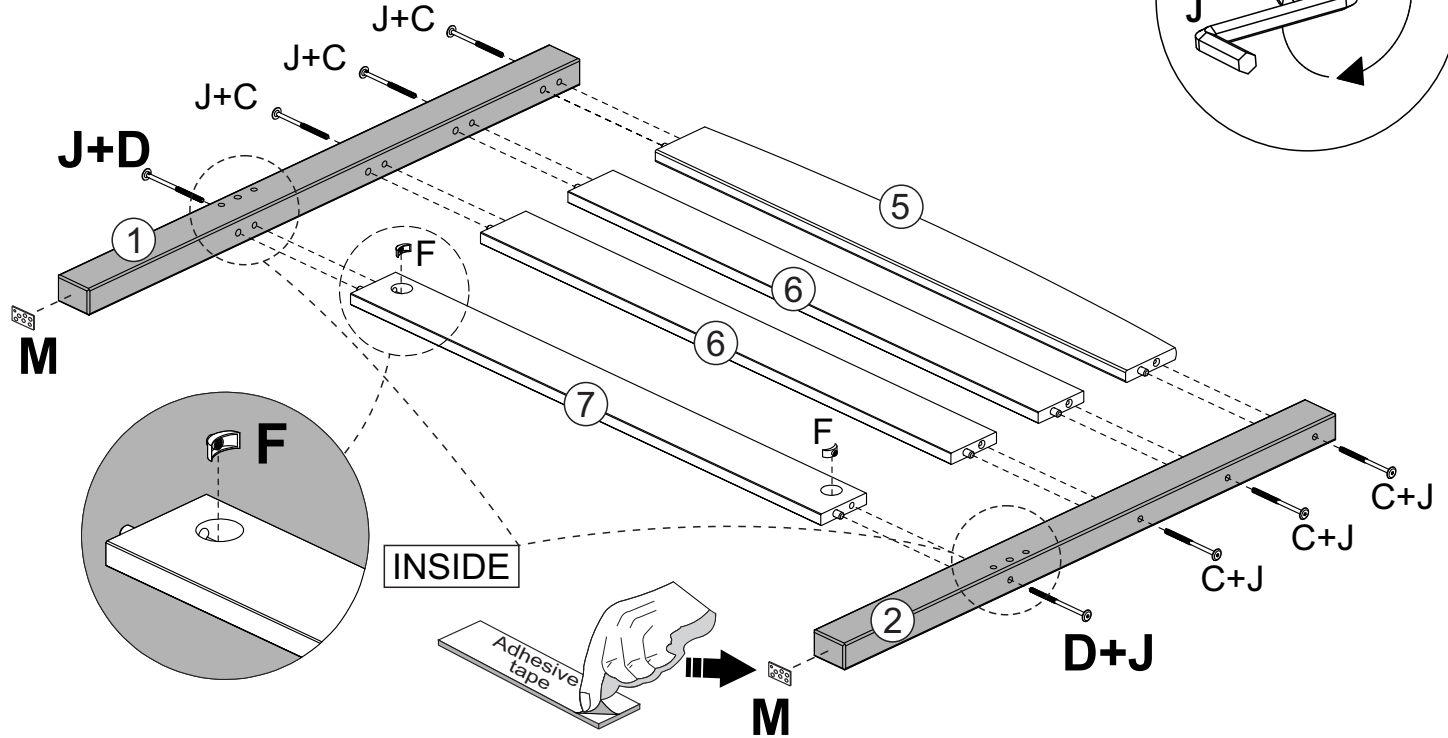
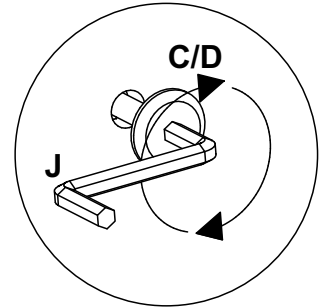
1) Insert wooden dowels (A) into the holes, as shown in the diagram.

Headboard

1) Attach parts 5, 6 and 7 on the post 1 and 2 with 2 bolts (D), 2 elliptical nuts (F) and 6 bolts (C), using the allen wrench (J).
 3) Remove the paper from the adhesive felt (M) and attach to the bottom of the posts 1 and 2



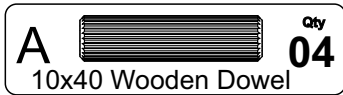
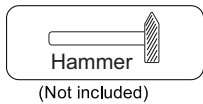
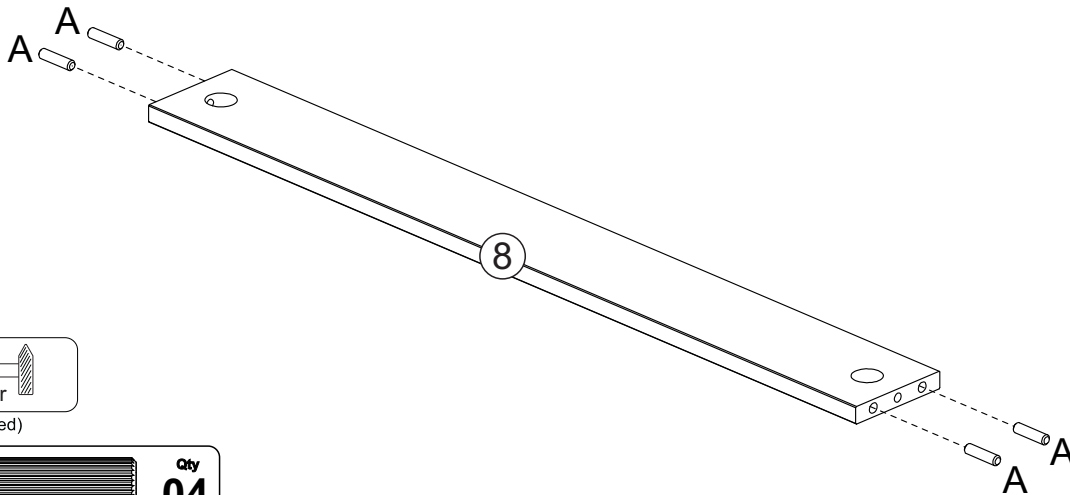

1) Insert wooden dowels (A) into the holes, as shown in the diagram.

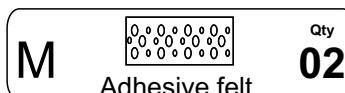
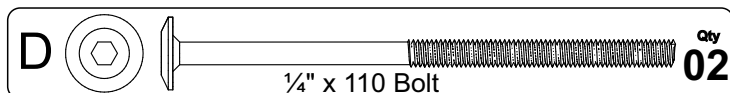
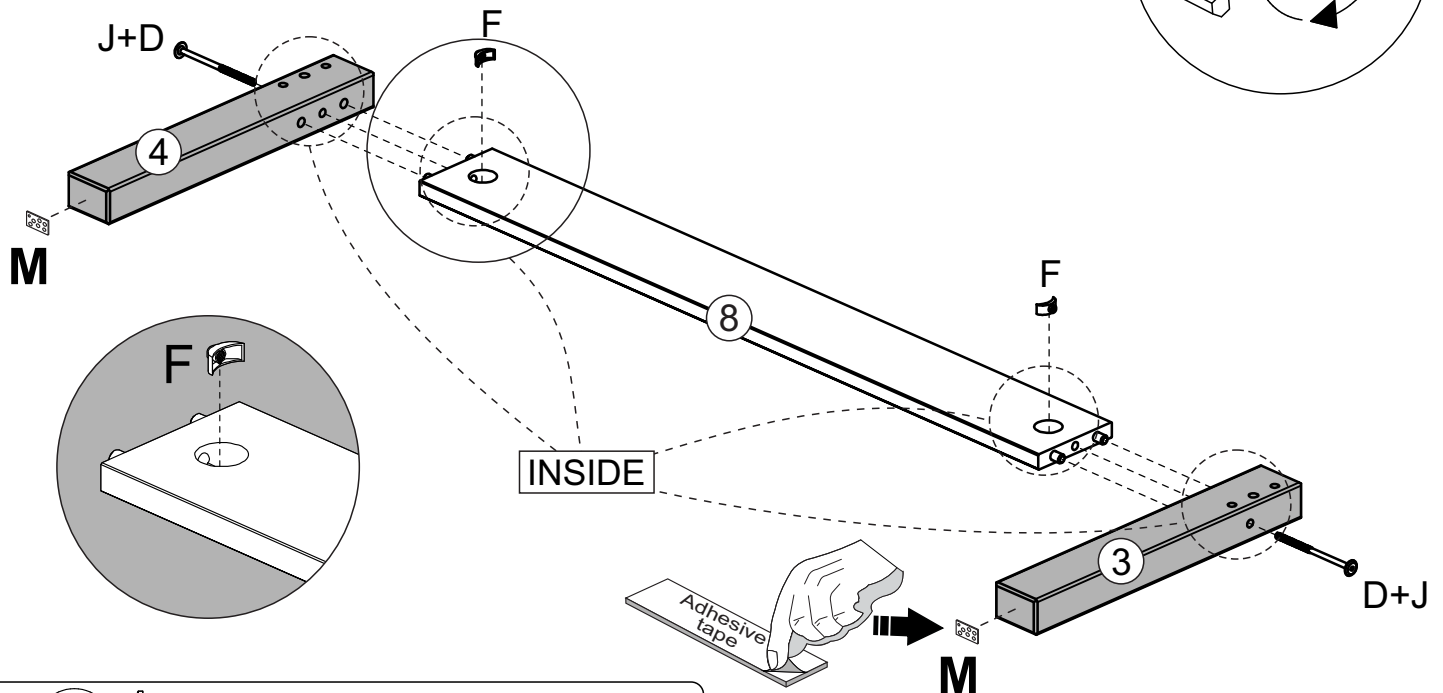
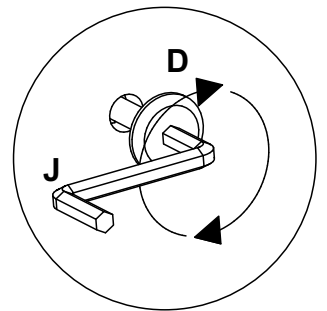


Step 4

1) Attach footboard panel 8 on the posts 3 and 4 with 2 bolts (D) and 2 elliptical nuts (F) using the allen wrench (J).

3) Remove the paper from the adhesive felt (M) and attach to the bottom of the posts 3 and 4



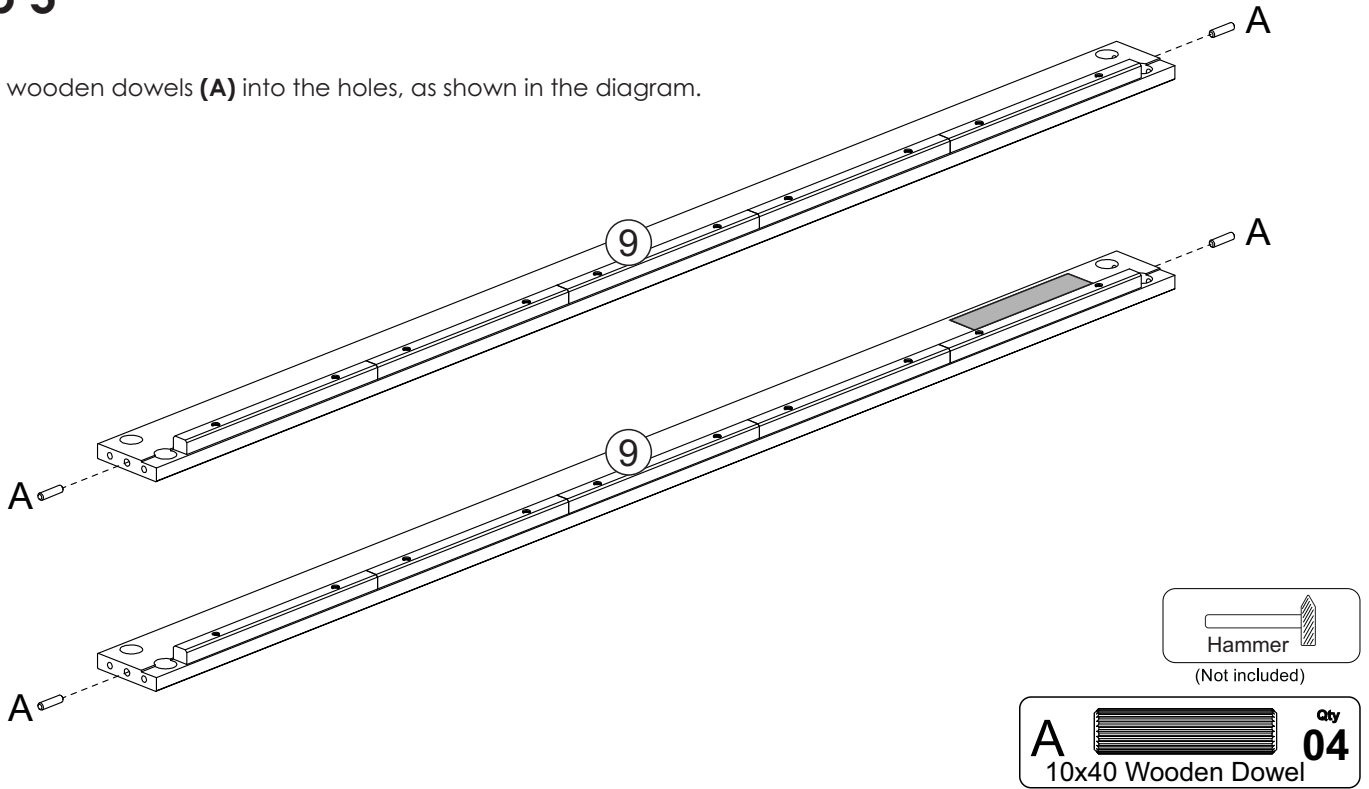

Rails

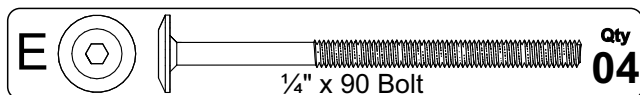
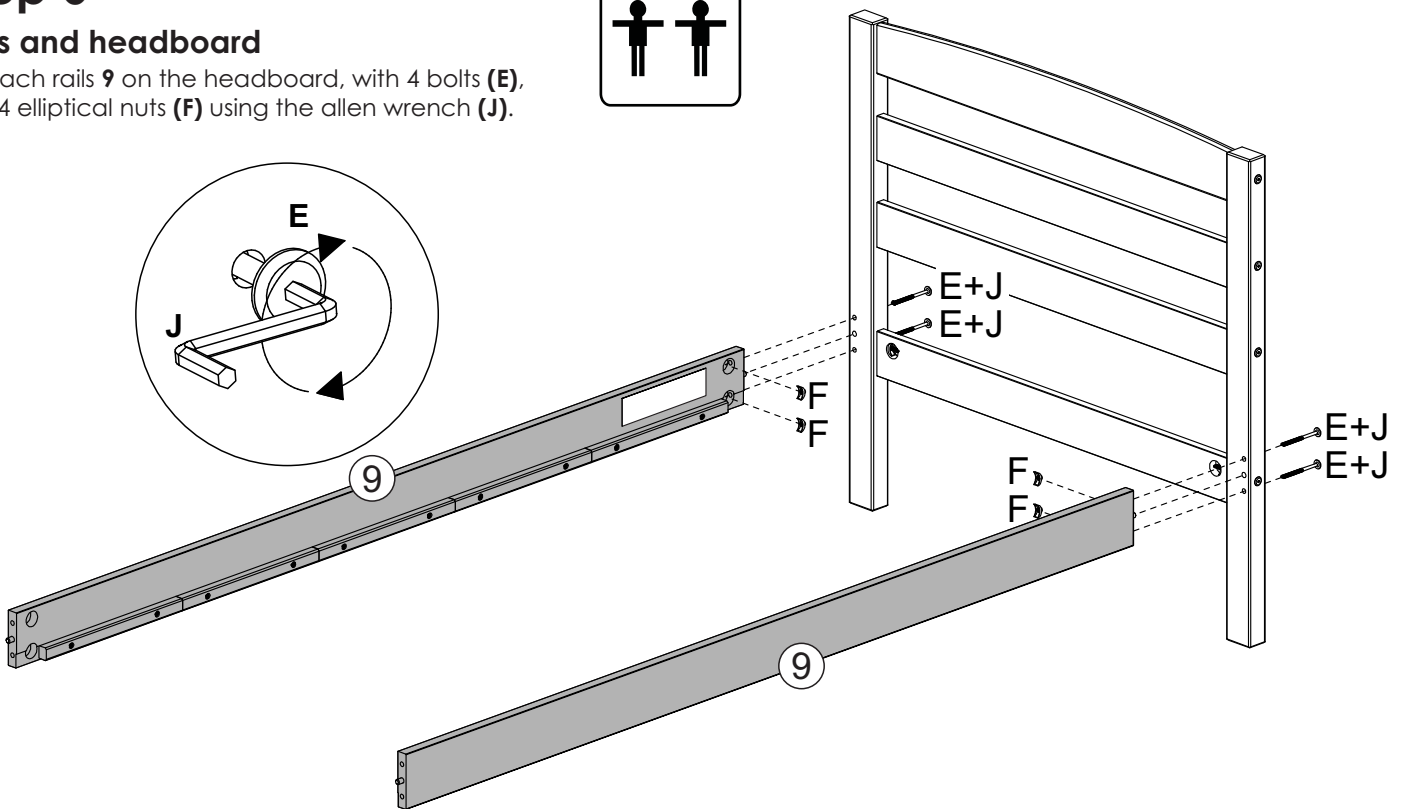
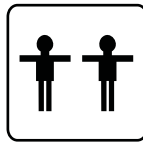
1) Insert wooden dowels (A) into the holes, as shown in the diagram.

1) Attach rails 9 on the headboard, with 4 bolts (E), and 4 elliptical nuts (F) using the allen wrench (J).



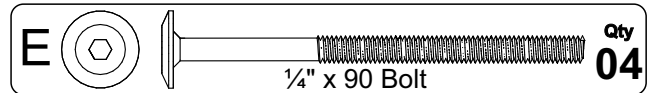
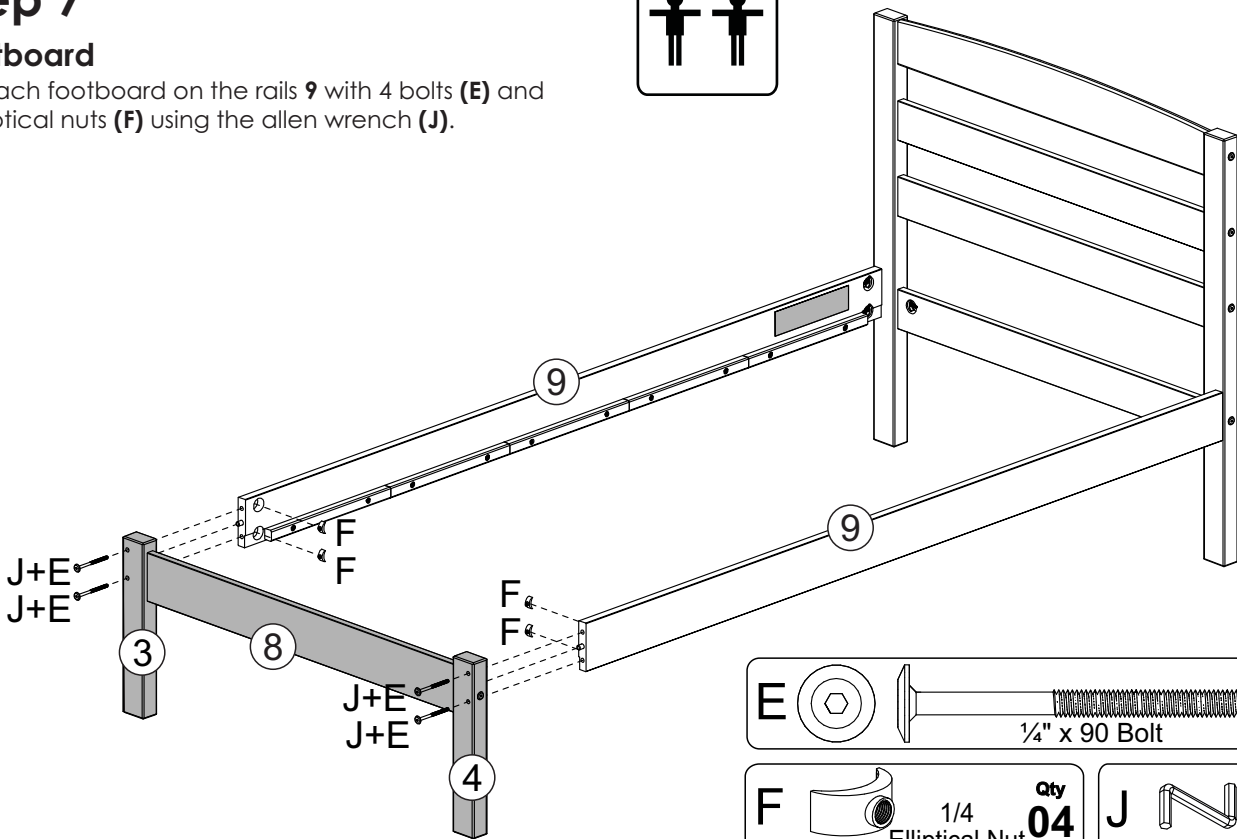
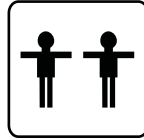

Footboard

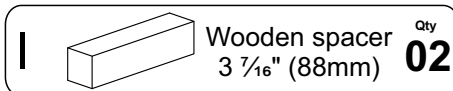
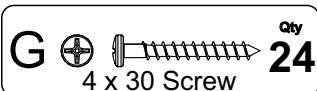
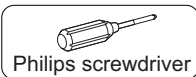
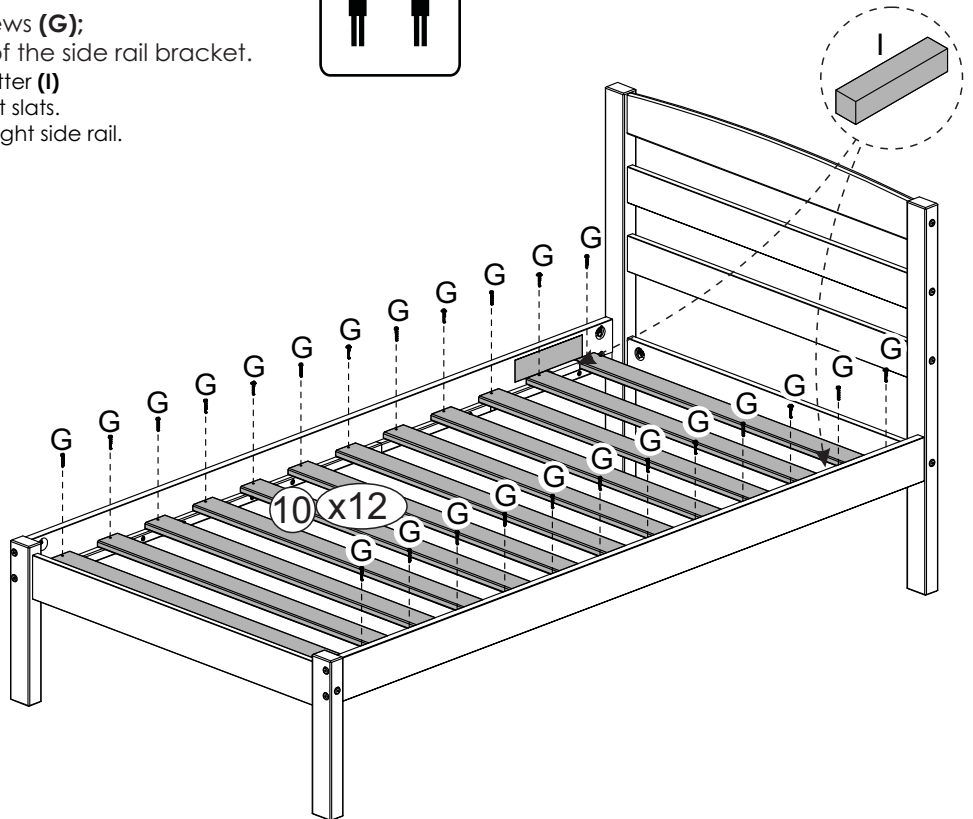
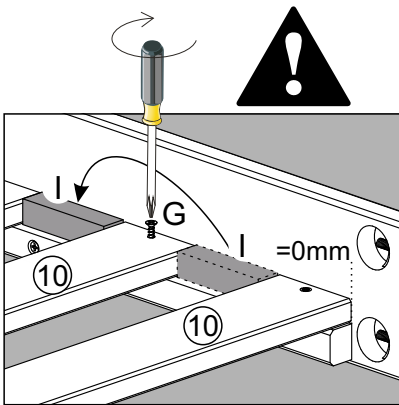
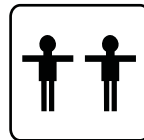
1) Attach footboard on the rails **9** with 4 bolts (**E**) and 4 elliptical nuts (**F**) using the allen wrench (**J**).



Step 8

Slats

1) Attach slats **10** on the rails with 24 screws (**G**);
 2) The first slat must be fixed to the end of the side rail bracket.
 3) After fixed the first slat use the hardware letter (**I**) to help define the space between each next slats.
 Use 1-(**I**) on the left side rail and 1-(**I**) on the right side rail.

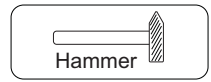
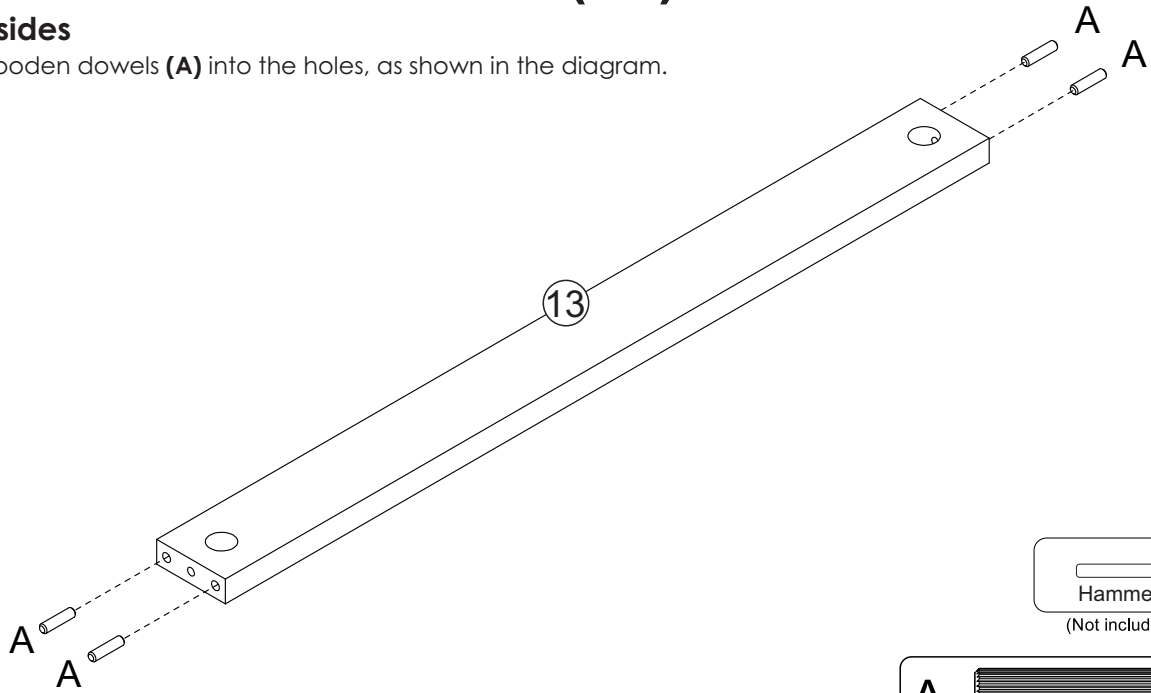

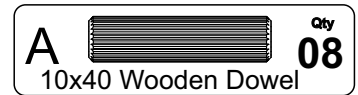
Trundle sides

Step 11

Trundle

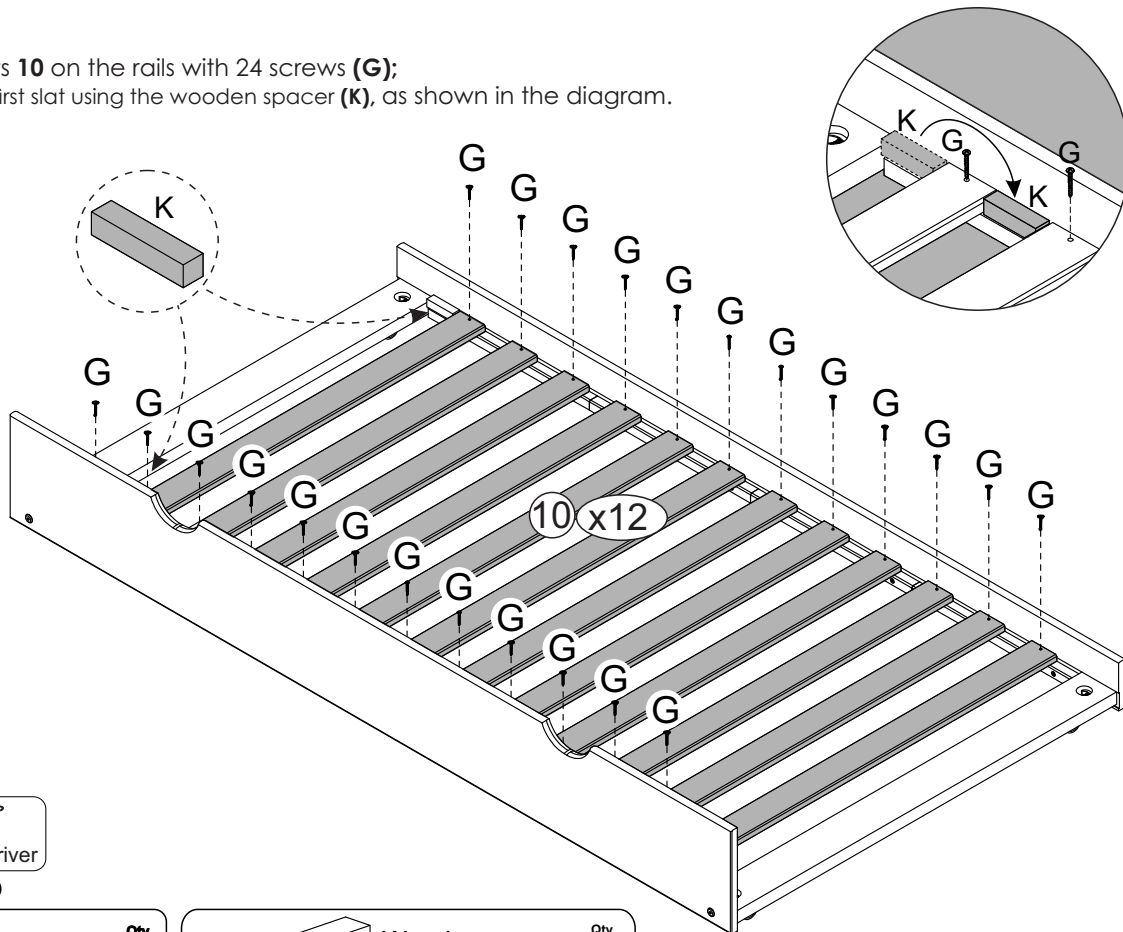
- 1) Attach the sides to the front of the trundle with 2 bolts (B) and 2 elliptical nuts (F), using the allen wrench (J).
- 2) Attach the back side to the sides with 2 bolts (B) and 2 elliptical nuts (F) using the allen wrench (J).



Step 12

Slats

- 1) Attach slats 10 on the rails with 24 screws (G);
- 2) Attach the first slat using the wooden spacer (K), as shown in the diagram.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE:

MAINTENANCE:

- Our furniture is designed to be low maintenance, however misuse, irregular use, or improper assembly can result in product malfunction. Regularly check the stability. If pieces feel loose or wobbly tighten all screws immediately.
- To store, review Assembly Instructions and reverse the steps to disassemble.
- Use only provided hardware to assemble and maintain assembly.

CARE:

- To clean use a soft, lint free rag similar to a cloth diaper and wipe away dust regularly. If necessary dampen cloth slightly with warm water and gently rub away spots. Dry thoroughly.
 - Do not use a bleach solution.
 - Do not submerge or allow to lie in standing water.
 - Do not use a sponge or harsh abrasive.
 - Do not use all purpose cleaners or harsh detergents.
 - Do not use Pine Oil cleaners or abrasive household cleaners.
 - Do not use heat or hot water.

ABOUT WOOD AND FINISH:

This product has been carefully crafted of MDF, solid pine wood and/or pine veneers. These materials derive from plantations, a renewable and well managed forest, therefore, not endangering the environment. The highest quality standards have been implemented to assure a sturdy and reliable product. Due to the natural variances in the graining of wood, you may notice subtle differences in the shading and tone of the color stain, warp, holes, wood knots and also small cracks. This is not a defect. But rather a result of the natural beauty of the wood itself.
