


Quadra Twin Bunk Bed

WARNING:

SIZE OF MATTRESS AND FOUNDATION

This bed is designed to use a twin mattress (37½" x 38½" x 74-75"). Mattress not included. A wood slat set is proved for the top bunk by the manufacturer.

The total thickness of the mattress and support must not exceed 7 inches.

NOTE: There MUST be at least 5 inches from top surface of mattress to top edge of guardrails.



WARNING:

To help prevent serious or fatal injuries from entrapment or falls:

- STRANGULATION HAZARD Never attach or hang items to any part of the bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to hooks, belts, strings and jump ropes.
- · Follow the information on warning labels on bed and carton. DO NOT REMOVE LABELS FROM BED.
- Always use the recommended size of mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- Ensure thickness of mattress and foundation combined does not exceed 7 inches and that the mattress surface is at least 5 inches below upper edge of guardrails.
- Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder and other components are in their proper position free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the distributor for replacement parts.
- · Never allow a child under 6 years on upper bunk.
- · Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
- The use of a night light may provided added safety for child on upper bunk.
- Prohibit horseplay on or under beds and prohibit jumping on or from bed.
- Always use ladder for entering or leaving upper bunk.
- If the bunk bed will be placed next to a wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
- Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk.
- The use of water or sleep flotation mattress is prohibited.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.







Insert 24 wooden dowels (A) into the holes on to parts 5, 6, and 22 as shown in the diagram.







Attach parts 5, 6, 10 and 22 on to part 3 with 4 bolts (C), using 1 Allen wrench (I).









Step 6 Bottom Rails

Insert 4 wooden dowels (A) into the holes on to parts 11, as shown in the diagram.









Attached the Front Guardrail to the front rail part 12 with 4 bolts (D), using 1 Allen wrench (I).






Bed Slats

1) Attached the first slat to the end of the side rail base with 2 screws **(E)**, using a phillips screwdriver.

- 2) Use the spacer (H) to limit the space between the slats.
- 3) Attach the slats 17 with 24 screws (E), using a phillips screwdriver.


4) Please note warping may occur because it is natural wood. To facilite the placement of the screws, you must press the two siderails simultaneously.









Step 19

Attach parts 9 on to parts 8 and 21 with 8 screws (E) using Philips screwdriver.



Ladder


Insert 6 wooden dowels (A) into the holes on to parts 19, as shown in the diagram.


Attach parts 19 on to part 18 with 3 bolts (D), using 1 Allen wrench (I).



MAINTENANCE:

CARE:
