Join us on a 3 day, 2 night visit to Sussex, where you can visit Chichester's Pallant House Gallery with its collection of Modern British Art, dating from the end of the 19th century to the present day; the historically fascinating Chichester Cathedral featuring works by Marc Chagall, John Piper and Graham Sutherland; the newly opened Novium Museum featuring, amongst other, Chichester's Roman history. Details on further places of local interest will be available on the coach.

We will be staying at Bognor Regis' Royal Norfolk Hotel from where we will venture out to Charleston, the country home of Vanessa Bell and Duncan Grant, recently sensitively restored. Also on the itinerary is Monk's House, the country retreat of Virginia and Leonard Woolf.

We shall return to Bristol via the National Trust's splendid Petworth House with its wonderful art collection, including major works by Van Dyck, Turner, Reynolds and Gainsborough. The house is surrounded by a 700 acre deer park, designed by Capability Brown.

Day Two: Coach will take us to Lewes area. Visits include Charleston and Monk's House. Day Three: Return to Bristol via Petworth House, aiming to arrive back in Bristol (All Saints Church) by 8.30pm.
