Vineyard

Location: Albury, Silent Pool, Surrey, England

Brief history of estate: Albury Vineyard is situated in the Surrey Hills AONB on the south face of the North Downs. Planted 2009/10, 13 acres, 21,000 vines, clay on chalk.

Viticulture: All the grapes are hand-picked from a single vineyard

Organic/Biodynamic: The vines are certified Organic and Biodynamic



Tasting Notes

Silent Pool Rosé 2018 is an elegant, fresh, classically pink-hued still rosé wine made from Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes. Subtle red berry and bright citrus aromas on the nose are followed by fresh summer flavours of strawberries and cream, peach and pink grapefruit on the palate. The wine is balanced by clean minerality and crisp acidity, with a long mouth-watering finish.

Food Match

Ideal as a summer aperitif and al fresco dining. Acidity in the wine means it's a perfect match for fresh, citrusy fish dishes - try local Tillingbourne trout with a lemon and crème fraiche dressing and grilled English asparagus. Soft, creamy English cheeses such as the organic Bath Soft also pair well with the crisp acidity and subtle red fruit of the wine. Take care not to overpower the delicate summer fruit flavours of this delicate rosé – light chicken, English lamb and roasted vegetable dishes are safe food matches.

Other Points of Interest

Albury Estate is the Surrey home of the Duke of Northumberland and is situated in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Our still rosé wine was served on the Royal Barge as part of the Queens Diamond Jubilee celebrations. Albury wines have won international awards and have been featured on the wine lists of several Michelin starred establishments including Le Manoir Aux Quat'Saisons, The Hand and Flowers, The Black Swan at Oldstead, Chez Bruce in Wandsworth, Sorrel in Dorking and The Clock House in Ripley. Albury Vineyard was voted Producer of the Year in the 2016 and 2018 Surrey Life Food & Drink Awards.
