



You may require some assistance to install the battery.






Locate battery door on bottom, unscrew the two screws and remove door.






Connect battery power plug in the right corner of the battery compartment. The plug fits into the port in only one way.





Locate power adapter in box and plug adapter into wall power socket.





Plug adaptor cord into its port at the left rear side of brailler.





Once connected, place the battery in the compartment and hold in place.





Close the battery cover, first inserting the tabs into the slots on the right. Screw the two screws back in place.
