### E'SCAPE 2022

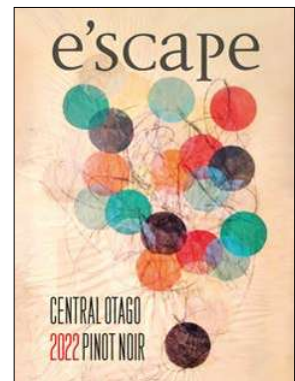
The Central Otago 2022 growing season was simply fantastic. Warm temperatures throughout the summer, followed by a hot, dry Autumn gave us perfect conditions for the ripening season. Quality fruit and fabulous weather during harvest allowed us to hand harvest early in the season with fruit in peak condition.

Our first vintage was in 2004, so, 20 years on, and with a multi-award portfolio of wines, we felt it was time to have a little fun and the result was E'scape!

E'scape is produced from a single clone of Pinot Noir in Block 6 which was planted in 2005. E'scape fruit was hand-picked, 100% de-stemmed, gently pressed and put to barrel. This wine has been filtered and is unfinned.

### *E'scape Pinot Noir 2022 - Tasting Note*

*Gorgeously fruited and inviting, the bouquet shows Black Doris plum, sweet cherry, rich floral and roasted nut aromas with a lovely spicy overtone. The palate displays excellent weight and concentration, wonderfully complemented by a smoothing mouthfeel and refined texture. Beautifully polished and harmonious with a persistent velvety finish. At its best: now to 2032*
