Sébastien Roulier is a doctor and passionate ultramarathon "Kartus changed my life! I was born with spastic quadriplegia, runner. His goal is to share this passion with as many people a type of cerebral palsy, a condition that affects your arms and legs. I've always had to find my way around in a wheelchair. I've never been able to walk. About a year and a half before finding out about Kartus, I first discovered running by flipping shared sense of happiness." There's no better feeling than putting your running veteran. Together, they broke two Guinness World Records: shoes on for the first time. Pure magic. Running isn't just a a half marathon in 1:30:37 and a marathon in just 3:01:24! source of well-being for me, it's an open door to freedom.

KARTUS MEETS SÉBASTIEN ROULIER

K: TALK TO US ABOUT YOUR **RUNNING BACKGROUND.**

S: I started running marathons in the year 2000 after a friend of mine completed his. I realized that marathons weren't just for professional athletes. Little by little, I signed up for more marathons throughout the year, adding up to around 7 or 8 per year. To make the marathon running process a bit easier, I decided to train to run up to 70k. That's when I signed up for my first 80k trail running ultramarathon. It turned out to be a revelation! My 2012 calendar became filled up almost exclusively by trail running. Over the years, I tried longer ones to complete several 160k races, until my longest race to date, the 250k Spartathlon in 2018. It was a privilege to represent my country at the World Trail Championships in 2013, 2015, and 2016, completing 100k in 2014 and then a 24-hour long one in 2019. Since then, I have won many awards and accolades in addition to winning a few of those 185 races.

K: MARIE-MICHELLE FORTIN SEEMS TO PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE AS YOUR CO-RUNNING PARTNER, COULD YOU **TELL US WHY THAT IS?**

S: Marie-Michelle and I worked together to bring co-running into the public sphere. We had an interesting first encounter. The Kartus team contacted me in April 2018 asking me if I would volunteer to be the partner of a co-runner who wanted to participate in the Lévis half marathon. I accepted right away, knowing I had an 80k run in Vermont the day before. Sometimes you just have to seize certain opportunities. It's a true pleasure to share the joys of running with someone. Despite her disability, Marie-Michelle is always smiling and gets as much out of it as any other runner. Not only did the half marathon win us a Guinness World Record, but it was the beginnings of a beautiful friendship. What also stuck with me was how grateful Marie-Michelle's parents were. The simple act of running and encouraging someone in the process has a positive domino effect on many individuals, myself included. Shared races are certainly not every co-runner's walk in the park. Marie-Michelle was already interested in running before finding out about Kartus. It's pretty extraordinary to witness someone's experience who has never walked a day in her life. She teaches

us a very important lesson: when life gives you the chance to break down barriers and further push yourself, you do it.

K: HOW IMPORTANT WOULD YOU SAY THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN RUNNER AND CO-RUNNER IS?

S: Just like in any running club, we develop friendships and bonds through training and the people we meet. Co-running bonds are built over time and distance. Whether we are participating in a race or doing a recreational activity, that special moment we share should not be taken for granted. Co-running breaks all barriers because at the end of the day, we are all runners.

IK: CAN YOU TALK ABOUT YOUR **BOSTON MARATHON EXPERIENCE?**

S: It was exceptional. An American man, who gave Marie-Michelle a Marathon jacket, referred to it as the "marathon of kindness".

I can relate it to my own experience perfectly. Although at first glance it seems I'm the one offering this gift to Marie-Michelle and that she is just benefiting from my generosity, the act of giving and receiving is a two-way street here. These kinds of experiences are really important to me. It was a sincere pleasure to get to rediscover the Boston marathon under a different light than last 12 times I've run it. The crowd cheered. 42k of screams and smiles. In those moments, you forget the pain. And to see the smiles on Marie-Michelle's parents' faces... it drives me to introduce the Boston Marathon to other co-runners.

NICOLE DUCHARME


Philippe Delisle and Nicole Ducharme met 27 years ago. Both big lovers of the outdoors, they soon shared their passions for camping, canoe-camping, kayaking, hiking, biking and cross-country skiing with each other. In 2017, after undergoing a cardio-vascular accident, Nicole was confined to a wheelchair. Faced with this new reality, she missed outdoor activities: it was much more difficult to get around in a wheelchair.

When the couple gave Kartus a try at the Sherbrooke Shared Runs, Nicole's whole world changed. She soon saw the chair as a companion rather than a burden! Not long after, they purchased their own.

Since then, Philippe and Nicole have been going on regular outings with the Kartus chair, both on paved paths or less accessible ones (stone dust, forest trails, lawns, etc.).

To quote Philippe, "Nicole can now reconnect with nature, and she says it's been "feeding her soul."





In recent years, Kartus has been featured in several longterm residences throughout the province of Quebec. You don't have to be an athlete to take this running chair around, anyone can do it, thanks to its easy maneuverability. People can enjoy the scenery at their own pace, always in pairs!
The Federation of Quebec Alzheimer Societies (FQMAMA), in Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, has also purchased Kartus chairs by the dozen, aiming to bring the joys of an active lifestyle to people with these diseases. A group of volunteer runners joined the initiative to spread the word about the project. Throughout Quebec, many long-term residences choose Kartus for its undeniable benefits of well-being, conversation when it involves getting some fresh air. health and overall quality of life.

Recreation technician Élise Beaudet says: "I'm always looking for new projects to better meet my clients' needs, and I first discovered Kartus at a symposium. I immediately "Outdoors" category hadn't really been explored.

The Kartus running chair is exactly what we need. Getting involved in the community, that sense of acceptance, belonging, freedom, all lie in the power of an outdoor stroll. Since the addition of these strolls and running outings, the residence's program has been completely transformed.

The resident's newfound sense of well being is just as important to me as the experience of sharing the outdoors. I love working with Kartus because I also happen to get a lot out of it: the fresh air, sunrise, being in nature and just getting out of your comfort zone is so refreshing. All our senses come alive, you can use just about any excuse for a

Families and volunteers can also enjoy intimate moments with the residents outside the facility, which allows for major bonding time. Residents feel heard and can forget about their illnesses for a while. One man even told me that he was knew I had to include it in my list of activities because our delighted he could rediscover his old neighbourhood, just like when he was a kid riding his bike! Events are now held every week in Quebec City, Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, Gatineau and Sherbrooke. It is a growing community where ties are getting stronger, and we are looking to expand the movement even further. The number of participants increases with each race: we're waiting for you!





THE SAGUENAY SHARED MARATHON: A TEMPLATE FOR FUTURE EVENTS!

The Saguenay Shared Marathon aims to encourage inclusion within the race. The first 2019 edition was a huge success: the fifty or so participants, including runners and co-runners, finished and came out of the race with flying colours.

According to the organizer, Dave McMullen, "Giving these people the thrill of being in a race is priceless. At the ultramarathon, we let them join in on the last kilometre and today, here they are doing the entire 42k! We as runners are secondary. This marathon is dedicated to them."








• RUN REGULARLY, BUT I'M NOT USED TO IT WITH KARTUS. IS IT DIFFICULT TO USE?

Running with Kartus is easy. The front steering wheel design makes the device easy to steer during your run. A smooth ride depends on a variety of factors, such as the passenger's weight or hills you may run into. However, the chair's inertia makes it easier to push on flat surfaces. In addition, the wheelchair is adjustable to any user, with options for handlebar position, brake levers and bottle placeholder.

O: CAN YOU EASILY FIT YOUR KARTUS IN THE CAR?

Yes, the Kartus chair comes with a foldable backrest and the wheels can be easily removed to fit the size of your vehicle. Once folded up, the chair can easily fit in a hatchback, SUV or minivan.

• I DON'T RUN, BUT I WALK AND I PREFER GRAVEL OR DIRT ROADS. DOES KARTUS WORK WELL IN THESE CONDITIONS?
