

## **Abbeville Storage - Six Cube Unit**









## Thank you for shopping with GLTC, we hope you enjoy having this product in your home.

We know assembling furniture, toys or accessories is not everyone's favourite way to spend their time, so we've tried to make assembling this item as quick and painless as possible.

Hopefully our efforts will have been worthwhile and you'll sail through the whole process. ## A few important pointers before you start:

- Please read the instructions right through before you start, and check that all the components have been included in the pack; we find separating all the hardware into piles makes it easier to be sure that everything is present and correct.
- Make sure you have the right tools. Allen keys are provided if required, but screw drivers and other tools are not. You'll find details of the tools you need at the beginning of the instructions.
- It's a good idea to build the unit in the room where you are going to be using it, to avoid the need to move it after it's been assembled.
- Do not throw away any packing materials until assembly is complete, just in case you accidentally discard smaller parts or hardware.

### **Safety Warnings:**

- · Adult assembly required.
- Unassembled product contains small parts which may present a choking hazard.
- Children should be kept away from the product during assembly to avoid any possible risk of injury.
- Assemble and use on a flat and level surface.
- DO NOT use power tools in the assembly of this product as there is a risk of over-tightening and consequently splitting of the wood.
- To avoid possible injury from tipping, DO NOT allow children to climb on this product.
- Always use the wall straps provided.
- Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tipping over.
   Ensure you secure this furniture product to the wall before you use it using the kit provided. If you have not received an anti-tip kit with your product please contact Customer Services.
- Check all fixtures and fittings regularly and tighten as necessary.
- Please retain these instructions for future reference.

#### **Customer Service:**

- If you find that any components are missing or damaged, please do not begin assembly and do not use the item. Please contact GLTC Customer Services on 0344 848 6000 immediately.
- We do stock spare hardware packs at our warehouse, so we should be able to send you a replacement pack immediately if required.

#### **Product Care:**

- Wipe clean using a soft damp cloth followed by a dry cloth.
- Do NOT use cleaning products which contain ammonia, solvents or abrasive material.
- Do NOT expose the item to extremes of heat and humidity.





## **Assembly:**



STEP I:

You are building this unit with the BACK facing up.

It is important to orientate the panels to understand where the top & bottom of the unit you are building is. The TOP of panel A has the larger drill holes on the panel, BASE has the smaller drill holes.


Slot in divider panel (A) into 2x shelf panels (B).

Ensure the small drill holes on the edge of panel A are facing you.

Ensure both shelf panels (B) have the large drill holes facing to the BASE. If you do not orientate these corectly, these fittings will be visible on your built product.


Hardware for Step 2:

8x #6 Wooden Dowels




**STEP 2:** Insert 8x wooden dowels (#6) into the ends of shelf panels (B) where indicated.


# Hardware for Step 3: 8x #2 Cam Dowels




**STEP 3:** Prepare the side panels C and D by attaching 8x cam dowels (#2), securing with a Philips screwdriver.




**STEP 4:** Slot in side panels C and D ensuring that the ledged side is facing upwards. Secure with 8x cam locks (#I) on both shelf panels (B).






**STEP 5:** Attach the base. Insert 6x wooden dowels (#6) and 6x barrel nuts (#4) at the bottom of the unit into panels D,A and C.

Locate the base panel (E) and align so that it connects with the main unit and secure with 6x Bolts (#3) using the allen key provided.






**STEP 6:** Prepare top panel (F) by inserting 6x wooden dowels (#6) and 6x cam dowels (#2).

## Hardware for Step 7:



6x #I Cam Locks




**STEP 7:** Attach the top. Align the top panel (F) to the top of the unit and slot into the main frame. Secure with 6x cam locks (#1) using a Philips screwdriver.

## Hardware for Step 8:






15x #5 Screws 14mm



**STEP 8:** Slot in the back panels G, H on to the top of the unit. Attach with 15x screws (#5) where indicated.

Please note that the 2x pilot holes indicated at the top of the unit are to attach 'antitip' straps included separately with this item.



**STEP 9:** Stand up the unit and it is ready to use.

Please be aware that we advise that safety straps are used to secure this to the wall, for details on securing the unit to the wall see the 'Anti-Tip Kit' guidance.
