A few important pointers before you start:

- It might be worth checking on our website that there are no updates or revisions to these instructions (if we have had helpful feedback from other customers we pass it on via the product web page). Simply check the date on the front of this leaflet against that of any site updates.
- Please read the instructions right through before you start, and check that all the components have been included in the pack; we find separating all the hardware into piles makes it easier to be sure that everything is present and correct.
- Make sure you have the right tools. Allen keys are provided if required, but screw drivers and other tools are not. You'll find details of the tools you need at the beginning of the instructions.
- It's a good idea to build the unit in the room where you are going to be using it, to avoid the need to move it after it's been assembled.
- Do not throw away any packing materials until assembly is complete, just in case you accidentally discard smaller parts and hardware.

- Adult assembly required.
- Unassembled product contains small parts which may present a choking hazard.
- Do not use this bed if any part is broken or missing.
- Children should be kept away from the product due to possible risk of injury.
- DO NOT use power tools in the assembly of this product as there is a rick of over-tightening and consequently splitting of the wood.
- Assemble and use on a flat and level surface.
- Children are likely to play, bounce, jump and climb on beds, therefore the child's bed should not be placed too close to other furniture or windows, and should be placed either tight to any wall or have a gap 300mm between the wall and the side of the bed.
- Check all fixtures and fittings regularly and tighten as necessary.
- Please ensure the room in which this bed is to be used is well ventilated or aired regularly in order to keep humidity low and to prevent mould growth in and around the bed.
- This bed needs a standard UK single mattress measuring 900mm × 1900mm.

Customer Service:

- If you find that any components are missing or damaged, please do not begin assembly and do not use the item. Please contact GLTC Customer Services on 0344 848 6000 immediately.
- We stock spare hardware at our warehouse, so we should be able to send you missing parts immediately if required.

Product Care:

- Wipe clean using a soft damp cloth followed by a dry cloth.
- DO NOT use cleaning products which may contain ammonia, solvents or abrasive material.
- DO NOT expose the furniture to extremes of heat and humidity.

Assembly: Phoenix Single Bed



STEP I:

Install 2 \times barrel nuts (#2) into 1 \times side rail (C) and then position the side rail onto 1 \times high bed end (B). **Note:** Please ensure the inserts on the slat support are facing up.

Install $2 \times hex$ bolts (#1) through the bed end (B) and secure into the barrel nuts, tightening with the allen key.

Repeat for the other side rail.





4x #2 Barrel Nut







STEP 2: 2 people required

Install 4 \times barrel nuts (#2) into the open ends of the side rails (C), then with a second person, lift the side rails and guide onto the low bed end (A).

Once held in position install $4 \times \text{hex bolts } (\#1)$ through the bed end and into the barrel nuts (#2) and tighten with allen key.

STEP 3:

Install the set of slats (D) and secure with $10 \times$ hex bolts (#3), tightening using allen key.
