

Thank you for shopping with GLTC, we hope you enjoy having this product in your home.

We know assembling furniture, toys or accessories is not everyone's favourite way to spend their time, so we've tried to make assembling this item as quick and painless as possible.

Hopefully our efforts will have been worthwhile and you'll sail through the whole process. A few important pointers before you start:

- Please read the instructions right through before you start, and check that all the components have been included in the pack; we find separating all the hardware into piles makes it easier to be sure that everything is present and correct.
- Make sure you have the right tools. Allen keys are provided if required, but screw drivers and other tools are not. You'll find details of the tools you need at the beginning of the instructions.
- Do not throw away any packing materials until assembly is complete, just in case you accidentally discard smaller parts or hardware.

Safety Warnings:

- Please read these instructions carefully before assembly.
- Adult assembly required.
- Unassembled product contains small parts which may present a choking hazard.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years due to small parts that may become detached and present a choking hazard.
- Children should be kept away from the product during assembly to avoid any possible risk of injury.
- Assemble and use on a flat and level surface.
- Adult assistance will be required to change over the table top.
- To avoid possible injury from tipping DO NOT allow children to sit, step or climb on the product.
- DO NOT use power tools in the assembly of this product as there is a risk of over-tightening and consequently splitting of the wood.
- Check item regularly for signs of damage which may make the product unsafe.
- Check all fixtures and fittings regularly and tighten as necessary.
- DO NOT use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- Please retain these instructions for future reference.

Customer Service:

- If you find that any components are missing or damaged, please do not begin assembly and do not use the item. Please contact GLTC Customer Services on **0344 848 6000** immediately.
- We do stock spare hardware packs at our warehouse, so we should be able to send you a replacement pack immediately if required.

Product Care:


- Wipe clean using a soft damp cloth followed by a dry cloth.

- Do NOT expose the item to extremes of heat and humidity.



Component Check List











2x #I Cam Dowels



STEP I:

Using a Phillips Screwdriver, insert $1\times$ cam dowel (#1) into the central hole on BOTH side rail panels A & B.




STEP 2:

Take panel B and insert 2x wooden dowels (#2) in the remaining central holes and then push support base panel C onto the hardware.

Insert 1x cam lock into the large drill hole on panel C at the connection point and turn clockwise to lock.

Repeat this step at the other end of panel C, joining it to panel A.



STEP 3:


Slide both base panels (D) into the groove of the side panels. It may be easier to slide each panel in from different ends.


STEP 4:

Carefully, turn the unit on its side,

Take both end panels E & F and insert Ix wooden dowel into the central drill hole on BOTH sides of EACH panel.


Take panel E and push into position on the ends of the side rails (A & B), lining up the groove with the base board.





Now insert the barrel nuts (#5) and bolts (#4) for the elevated side rail. You will have to do these one at a time, holding the barrel nut in place whilst you secure the bolt.

Repeat this step with panel F.



STEP 5:

Once all the bolts on the end panels are fully secure, carefully turn the play table over and insert the play surface panels G & H.

Your unit is now complete.
