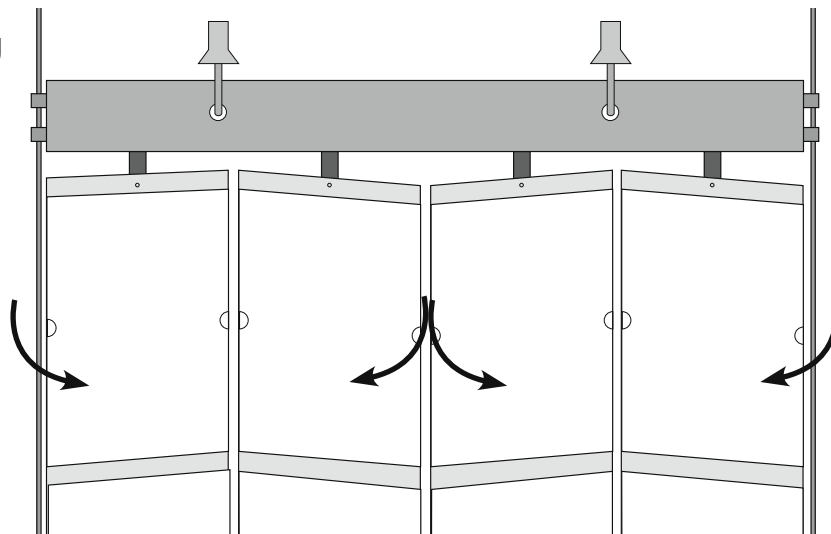


## Frequently Asked Questions about Rotating Displays

### Q. Which way do the blades rotate?

A. They can turn either way. Unless you specify they will be set to contra-rotate, this means they will each turn in opposite directions. You can specify when you order the display, for them to all turn in the same direction.

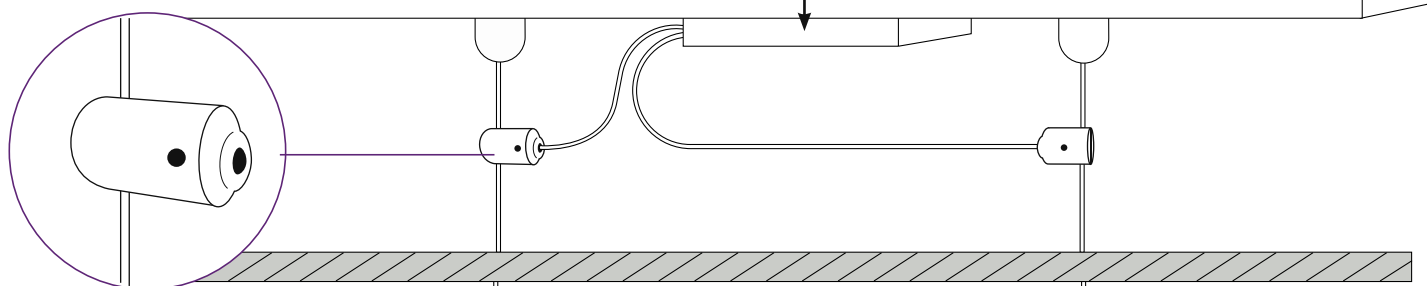
#### Contra Rotating Blades



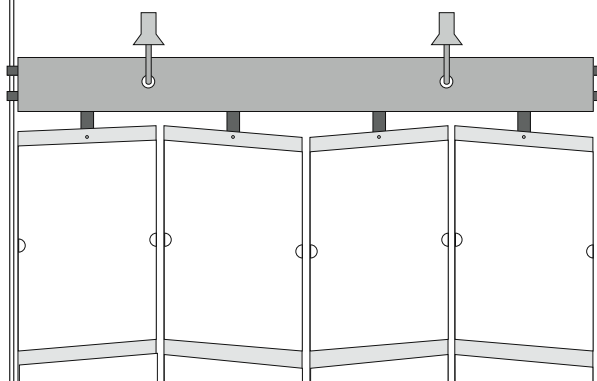
### Q. What powers the Display?

A. The Rotating Display is powered by a 12volt transformer, this makes the unit very efficient and cost effective to run. The transformer is small and can be hidden above a suspended ceiling if available or down on the skirting board. The transformer should be connected to the 6mm rods which support the display. Do not connect the transformer to the rotating display directly!

### Q. Can I control the speed that the display rotates at?

A. No, the speed that the display rotates at is preset. The motor turns the blades at 2.5 rpm. The idea is that if the blades turn too quickly you do not see them turning and therefore do not become curious about the display. The fact that you see them turning makes the customer interested in what you have in your window.
