CNA Documentaries to Debut on Netflix as Part of Distribution Deal with Mediacorp

Singapore, 27 July 2021 – Close to 80 hours of locally-produced documentaries, animations, and dramas – Netflix subscribers can look forward to these local delights and more in August as Singapore celebrates its 56th birthday. Following a content deal forged with Mediacorp, Netflix will stream homegrown content from Singapore's largest content creator to its audiences in the Asia Pacific region, with titles from CNA making their debut on the global streaming giant's platform.

A total of 10 CNA-produced documentaries will be available on-demand on Netflix for the first time. Nature enthusiasts can get themselves lost in *Wild City: Forest Life*, which features fascinating wildlife in Singapore's urban jungle such as the Raffles' banded langur. Narrated by the legendary Sir David Attenborough, this is the fourth episode in the acclaimed Wild City series which explores the wild side of the tropical city state. Other titles include award-winning investigative series *Undercover Asia* and *Get Real*, both of which delve into the most intriguing issues and developments in the region.

Marking another first for Mediacorp is Netflix's acquisition of two locally-produced animation series: *Downstairs* and *Lil' Wild*. Voiced by familiar personalities such as mrbrown (Lee Kin Mun) and Patricia Mok, *Downstairs* features the crazy adventures of a band of wacky Kopitiam stalls owners in their neighbourhood. *Lil' Wild*, a children's animation series directed by illustrious animator and director Sergio Delfino, tells the tale of a colourful cast of animals from different continents living side by side in a zoo.

Drama fans have plenty to get excited about as well, with critically acclaimed English period dramas *Titoudao: Inspired by the True Story of a Wayang Star* and *Last Madame*, starring Joanne Peh, set to be available on Netflix from 5 and 6 August, respectively. Rounding up the list of Mediacorp dramas to keep Netflix viewers on the edge of their seats are *Beijing to Moscow*, which clinched the title of Best Short-Form Drama Series at Star Awards 2021, and Malay drama series *Forensik*, a spin-off of the popular English drama *Code of Law*.
