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Episode 1 - Chinatown

Darren tours Chinatown with illustrator Francis. A group of volunteers who set up gourmet website to help mothers from low-income families to earn extra income & set up reading plans for kids. Visit two young hawkers who provide free meals for the elderly as well as a shoemaker and a scissors maker.

Episode 2 - Ang Mo Kio

Ang Mo Kio is full of hidden gems. An old uncle, who rides a unicycle & sells high-end dried seafood, Thai boat noodles for \$1, freshly mixed Chinese curry paste, 24-hour private container gym, a high-end fashion store, a private bicycle museum & 3D murals in the neighbourhood. Enjoy all at one go.

Episode 3 - Jalan Besar/ Little India

Let's learn about the history & allusion of streets in Jalan Besar & the hidden gems. A soup kitchen that provides free meals for foreign workers, a Chinese zhaitang, a vintage shop hidden in a hardware shop, an underground art gallery in an old dormitory & a Thai Tom Yum fish soup stall with story.

Episode 4 - Jurong / Bukit Batok

Due to the pandemic, a four-generation family sells fish to tide through the difficult times together, a couple uses social media to market their 8-inch pizzas. Another couple photographs newborns to record the memorable moments for the parents. A mobile doctor who attends to the homebound elderly.

Episode 5 - Holland Village / Clementi

A Xi'an eatery caters to the palates of the new immigrants living in Clementi. A celebrity chef helps hawkers to go digital for free. Freshly made buns with new flavours at Holland Village to attract younger crowds. Bring own bottles to buy organic detergent from a van that comes to your doorstep.

Episode 6 - Sengkang / Punggol

A patissier, who has lost her eye sight after childbirth, continues baking at home. A couple turns their love for cockles into a home business. A young mum carves local landmarks onto rubber stamps. A home-based hairdresser uses art to overcome depression. Have a fun trip at the Marsiling Tunnels.

Episode 7 - Geylang/Kallang

Photographer Eric helps foreign workers to take free makeover photos. Do charity with online grocery shopping as accumulated proceeds of the items are donated to the needy. A five-star hotel chef, who has taken a wrong turn in life, serves up a second chance with steamed dishes at a hawker centre.

Episode 8 - Yishun

Visit Chong Pang to get a feel of human touch. Find the kampong coffee shop in Seletar & an old-school biscuit shop, that has more than 300 types of biscuits to choose from, in Yishun. Follow a mobile Muay Thai truck to watch young & old learn Muay Thai. Lastly, follow host to catch ants at night.

Episode 9 - Hougang / Macpherson

Darren visits Circuit Road Food Centre to find out why there are so many vegetarian stalls around & discovers the kampung spirit among stall owners. He also talks to MP Tin Pei Ling about recent changes in Macpherson. Two young girls each set up business in a same building & leads own exciting life.

Episode 10 - Queenstown / Redhill

There are a thousand of street sleepers locally. We talk to a couple who used to live by the beach & hear how they overcame their difficulties. A super chef who helps young hawkers sell Mee Hoon Kueh during pandemic, a mobile coffee cart & one who knits hand-dyed hats for the poor children overseas.

Episode 11 - Toa Payoh

An uncle opens a private kitchen in Potong Pasir & also sells used items to raise funds for orphanage in Philippines. Filipino maids offer to help. A designer makes dumplings at home with unique flavours like Bak Kut Teh & Kimchi. A vending machine that sells \$2 items is popular with the residents.

Episode 12 - Bedok

A private heritage museum that is hidden in a private residential estate. A dessert shop that is hidden in a shopping mall, a HDB coffee shop that sells cheap crab stir-fry. The boss of a vinyl shop in Simpang Bedok who keeps expensive speakers. A strange owner of a barber shop who cannot cut hair.

Episode 13 - Katong/Joo Chiat

A shop in Joo Chiat sells wagyu beef that is shipped from Japan daily and selling at affordable prices. Two ex-teachers open a hand-woven fabric shop and bring their traditional crafts to the community. Two young girls start a clothing line for dogs and are struggling with their business venture.



第一集: 牛车水

第二集:宏茂桥

宏茂桥社区卧虎藏龙,骑单轮卖高档海产的老伯、卖一块钱的泰国船面、现买现调的华人咖喱料、24小时有隐私集装箱健身房、高档货潮店,不是每个人都能参观的私人脚车博物馆和邻里中心的3D壁画,让你一次玩个够。

第三集:惹兰勿刹/小印度

通过文史达人的带领,了解惹兰勿刹的街道典故与历史。以及隐藏的人事物,有为客工提供免费餐食的爱心厨房、不为人知的华人斋堂、一间隐藏在五金店的古着店,藏在旧劳工宿舍里的地下画廊和有故事的泰北冬炎鱼汤档。

第四集:裕廊/武吉巴督

四代同堂卖鱼,因疫情让一家人共同面对难关。比萨夫妻档,因疫情寻新机,利用网络平台做优惠,八寸薄比萨吸睛。另一对夫妻档,以相机为新生婴儿父母记录宝宝最初的模样。流动医生出诊,为行动不便老人提供登门服务。

第五集:荷兰村/金文泰

金文泰是新移民落脚第一个新镇,西安小吃店抚慰新移民的味蕾。名厨为小贩门免费拍摄照片和视频,帮助小贩网上寻新机。荷兰村的现做现卖包点,引来新口味,吸引年轻食客。有机清洁剂货车开到你家门,自备瓶子来买货。

第六集: 盛港/榜鹅

五星级甜点师傅诞下儿子后失明,在家烘焙爱心蛋糕。爱吃蚶的夫妻档,因疫情转战居家卖蚶生意。另有一位年轻妈妈,把本地特色景物留在橡皮章篆刻上。居家理发师,以作画走出忧郁的困扰。走一趟马西岭隧道,乐趣无穷。

第七集: 芽笼/加冷

为客工免费做造型拍照,摄影师Eric是客工口中的"甜心爸爸"。在网站超市购物,还能做善事,每购买一件物品,都能积累成多,捐赠给有需要的人。五星级酒店厨師,因行差踏错转战熟食中心,以蒸食虏获饕客的味蕾。

第八集: 义顺

走一趟忠邦社区,感受浓郁人情味。再到实里达寻找阿兵哥口中的龙门客栈甘榜咖啡店。然后到义顺的古早味饼干店,300多种饼干任你选。跳上流动泰拳车,到组屋社区,看看年长老幼学泰拳。最后跟着主持人夜晚捉蚂蚁。

第九集: 后港/麦波申

主持人明伦到麦波申循环路熟食中心, 寻访为何素食档如此多的原因, 发现档主们互助互爱的邻里精神, 同时采访该区陈佩玲议员, 畅谈麦波申社区近年的转变。在同一栋大厦内, 两名年轻女生创业, 际遇不同, 人生一样精彩。

第十集: 女皇镇/红山

本地有整千名街头露宿者,各自有因而以街头为家,我们访问曾住在海边的夫妻,如何度过难关。疫情当前,有超级厨师协助有意当小贩的年轻人卖面粉粿,也有四处飘香的流动咖啡车和在家手染纺线织帽送给国外贫困儿童。

第十一集: 大巴窑

波动巴西的爱心伯伯,开办私房菜和卖旧货,筹款给在菲律宾的孤儿院,爱心感动不少菲律宾女佣自动上门帮忙。设计师在家做饺子,风味独特,有肉骨茶、泡菜和苹果香蕉。食物贩卖机售卖两块钱货品,深受社区居民的欢迎。

第十二集: 勿洛

隐藏在私人住宅区的旧货私藏博物馆, 犹似走入历史时光隧道。还有秘藏在购物中心里的甜品店, 组屋楼下咖啡店的平价螃蟹煮炒, 在新邦勿洛的黑胶唱片行, 老板秘藏售价不菲的扬声器, 以及不懂得剪发却开着理发厅的怪人。

第十三集:加东/如切

如切有家和牛肉店,每天从日本运来一整头和牛,售卖价格较平民化的和牛肉。两位放弃教职的老师,开办手纺布店,把传统技艺带到社区。而两位年轻女生,为了给狗狗选择适合的服饰,开创狗狗服饰品牌,创业路走得艰难。
