Episode 1: THE GHOSTS OF FUKUSHIMA

Over eight years have passed since the Fukushima nuclear catastrophe in Japan. Today the country is in the midst of an unprecedented project – decontaminating and repopulating towns and villages polluted by radioactive elements.

Episode 2: TURNING ACEH'S TIDE

December 26th 2004. Banda Aceh is ravaged by the worst tsunami in modern times. This is the remarkable tale of survival, and extraordinary efforts of its people, the country and the international community to bring a city back to life.

Episode 3: KAL 858: Flashpoint Korea

In 1987, Korean Air Flight 858 exploded in mid-air en route to Seoul, killing all 115 passengers on board. Pyongyang was immediately blamed for the attack. But is there more than meets the eye?

Episode 5: TOKYO'S SARIN SCARS

Tokyo, March 20, 1995. Subway commuters begin to choke and collapse. They've been poisoned with sarin gas. Disciples of an obscure New Religion have decided they need to kill all of humanity to save mankind. How did this happen and why?

第一集: THE GHOSTS OF FUKUSHIMA

第五集: TOKYO'S SARIN SCARS

1995年3月20日的一天,东京的地铁乘客突然被不明的毒素呛着,接着一个个倒下。原来,他们被沙林气体袭击。一个新宗教认为屠杀人类才是拯救世界的唯一方式。这些人是谁? 他们为何有那么极端的思想? 这个悲剧又是怎么发生的?
