

INSIDE A MAGICAL JUNGLE HOME

Behind the gates of Baan Botanica is a technicolor retreat filled to the hilt with personal treasures, plants and art. The maximalist jungle paradise in the heart of Bangkok is home to internationally acclaimed designer and landscape architect Bill Bensley and his partner, a horticulturalist with fantastical tastes.

A LIFE OF ITS OWN

Located next to a golf course, the Diagonal House is a multi-generational family residence which exemplifies modern tropical architecture. Consisting of a triangle, circle and square, the house blends nature into its design, working around slopes and even trees to create a stunning, unique home.

BIRTHED FROM A SACRED VOLCANO

The family home of Maximilian and Stefanie Jencquel is nestled in a magnificent valley in the lush forests of Ubud. Overlooking the sacred volcano, Mount Agung, the property reflects Bali's natural elements, incorporating lava stone and fiery terracotta. It's a sanctuary for their young family.

GROUNDED IN LOVE

Kunal and Pallavi Prasad's six-bedroom estate is a stunning oasis situated in the sprawling gardens of South Delhi. Their house is designed to accommodate the family's passion for the outdoors and love for entertaining with a luxury pool, an exquisite vegetable garden and their own yoga gazebo.

Episode 3 – Unboxing Unconventional Asian Homes

OUTSIDE THE BOX

A nine-metre high structure with intersecting bamboo poles arches over the gymnasium of Green School Bali. Elora Hardy, the architect behind this award-winning structure, is on a mission to show how sustainable architecture can be achieved through the use of bamboo and advances in technologies.

'UNBOXING' AN UNCONVENTIONAL JAPANESE HOME

This five-block Tokyo residence has been artfully designed around the terrain. From the carefully selected furniture and fixtures to the beautifully framed pockets of greenery, architect Hideki Ishii plays with light and shadow as well as spatial design to create surprising vignettes and cosy rooms.

PROUDLY ROOTED IN TRADITION

Sitting in the heart of New Delhi is interior designer Amrita Guha's five-story duplex. Amrita is known for her contemporary approach to Indian design, reviving and preserving Indian traditions. Peppered around her house are exquisite art, sculptures, and furniture that tell a story of the country's history.

Episode 4 - Modern Marvels

A HOME FOR MUSIC AND ART

In Matsumoto, Japan, the residence architect Hitoshi Saruta built for his mother and siblings is a unique blend of contemporary design, local culture and architecture. Using traditional architectural techniques, he constructed an adjoining building fit for his brother to teach and practise music.

A MODERN MARVEL

Situated next to a golf course, the 'Bunker House' is designed to be closed and private with steel walls covering the entire property. In contrast to its harsh exterior, the free space inside and its central courtyard keeps the home open and airy to make residents feel comfortable.

WRAPPED IN THE BEAUTY OF RAIN

Nestled in the quiet neighbourhood of Campuhan is a villa complex designed by architect Maximilian Jencquel. The project began with a serendipitous opportunity to acquire precious ironwood from a decommissioned bridge. Using logs of reclaimed wood, the project evolved from its original plans.
