

Volunteering TIPS

Packing Tips

- **Summer** Temperatures in TLV are often around 29° to 35° Celsius, humidity around 70 to 80%. It easily feels like 40+ degrees! Bring lots of shirts, shorts and airy cloth with you, but don't forget the thin jacket and long pants for the sometimes cool nights, as well for possible sightseeing tours ("Holy Sites" require knee long and shoulder covered clothing)
- **Winter** Temperatures in TLV are often around 11° to 19° Celsius, but in the night, they can drop to 3 ° to 8 ° Celsius! Especially inside houses it can feel very cold! Bring warm clothing, a rain jacket/pants and if you are cold easily even gloves and a hat.
- **Generally** bring things like swimwear, sunglasses, backpack, comfortable shoes and Flip Flops

Other things to bring

- Adaptor for your electronics - check here <https://www.power-plugs-sockets.com/israel/>
- Israeli SIM card – do NOT buy one at the airport and have a chat with us when you are here, there is free WIFI in many places.
- Passport - valid for at least 6 months after your departure of Israel
