INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing this Profile Design bar. These instructions apply to the Aeria¹ Evo complete bar with Ergo armrests and 35a extensions.

Please read these instructions thoroughly before attempting to install this item. Proper installation is required for compliance with Profile Design's warranty policy. If you are not familiar with the installation of aerobars or their accessories, please seek the assistance of your local Profile Design dealer by logging on to www.profile-design.com and using "Dealer Locator" or by calling Profile Design's customer service number p.# 888.800.5999.

Note to Dealers: If you install this product for the consumer, please provide him/her with this owner's manual after installation.

Tools and materials required:

- 5mm Hex Wrench
- 4mm Hex Wrench
- Torque Wrench with a 4mm and 5mm Hex fitting
- Assembly compound
- Lithium grease
- Isopropyl alcohol
- Cutting guide and hacksaw (18T blade for Aluminium, 32T for Carbon) Or a pipecutter for aluminium
- Half round file
- Electrical/Insulation tape
- Clean, lint free cloth




If anything is missing from the aerobar kit please contact your dealer.

Please note that threaded areas have been pre-treated by Profile Design during production with a special blue thread locking compound. This special compound is easy to detect on the threads of all bolts provided. If you cannot detect this thread locking compound or you are re-installing the bolt, re-apply a suitable blue thread locking compound as available from Loctite® or another company before assembly.

Periodically check the aerobars for damage, particularly for scratches through the anodised coating that could lead to oxidation and weakening of the aluminum. Replace your aerobars if you notice any damage from use or accident.








MAXIMUM EXTENSION LENGTH


Please note that the maximum length from the rear of the bracket to the tip of the extensions is 430mm.








BOLT LENGTHS

- Aerobar Stack is the height of the top of the pads above the centre of the basebar including the cushion.
- Note that the bridge, if used, counts as a 5mm spacer.
- The Bridge should be used for spacer heights above 40mm
- The table shows the aerobar stack with different armrest choices:











ASSEMBLY COMPOUND

- 9. Adjust the angle of the bracket by altering the depth of the bolts in the barrels.
- 10.Once you are satisfied with the angle and have matched both sides, use the Torque wrench with 5mm Hex to tighten the bolts to 6Nm.






THREADLOCKER




- $11.\, To$ install the extensions in an aerobar bracket, first apply a light coating of assembly compound to the inner faces of the extension clamp.
- 12. Install the extensions in the desired position and tighten the M5 extension fixing bolt using the 4mm Hex wrench so they are held snugly.



- Install the shifters (if using bar end models) as per the shifter manufacturer's instructions. We recommend a light coating of assembly compound on the inside of the extension prior to installing the shifter.
- Install the cables as per instructions from the shifter manufacturer. We suggest routing the cables by pushing through from the cable exit hole on the bracket.
- Then use the torque wrench with a 4mm fitting to tighten the extension clamp to 5Nm.


- 13.Carefully determine the required extension length by performing a bike fit or measuring the existing extensions.
 - The Aeria¹ Evo bracket allows 40mm of extension length adjustment beyond the minimum insertion. We recommend cutting the extensions 20mm longer than the minimum insertion point so you have room to both shorten and lengthen the extensions easily.
 - The windows in the bracket show the minimum insertion you must not be able to see through the extension shaft.

14. Apply a thin layer of lithium grease to the surface of the wing mount.




How to cut the extensions


- 1. Mark the cut line on the extensions.
- We recommend checking your measurements after first marking the cut line to ensure that you do not inadvertently cut the extensions too short.
- If using a cutting guide mount it securely in a vice. Then place the extension in the guide and line up the marked cut line with the slot in the cutting guide.
 - For aluminium an 18 tooth blade is recommended. Along with eye protection.
 - For carbon a 32T or carbon specific blade is recommended. Wrap the extension with insulation tape at the cut line to limit the risk of splintering the carbon at the blade exit point.
- If cutting carbon, wear a breathing mask, gloves and eye protection then dispose of the dust residue carefully. Airborne dust particles are a respiratory hazard
- Using the hacksaw, make firm strokes of the blade through the guide, allowing the blade to do the work. Do not apply excessive force to the hacksaw as you risk snapping the blade and the possibility of injury.
- 6. Alternately, if you are using a pipe cutter (only on aluminium extensions) – first apply insulation tape either side of the cut line to protect the finish of the extension from the rotating wheels.
- Line the cutter up carefully with the cut line then rotate with a smooth motion, gradually depressing the cutting wheel further as the cut depth increases.
- 8. Repeat the process for the second extension.
- Once you have cut both extensions, use the half round file to remove any sharp edges from both the interior and exterior faces of the extension.




How to Install new armrests


- To fit the armrests first ensure the inner face of the armrest is free of lint and grease, if the armrest has previously had a hook and loop sticker applied the residue should first be removed either mechanically or with a citrus based solvent.
- Before applying the hook and loop sticker, you may choose to wipe down the surface with isopropyl alcohol to ensure good adhesion. Remove the backing from the hook and loop sticker and apply it to the armrest, smoothing the sticker out to ensure there are no air bubbles trapped under it.
- 3. Allow the sticker 24 hours to cure before use.






ARMREST USAGE
