# Reusable sandwich bags make going green easy

## Cloth

Food wraps out of cloth have been used for centuries, but we've got better choices now than bundling a sandwich in a linen napkin. **LunchSkins** FDA-grade sandwich and snack bags (\$10.99 for a two-bag set) are light but sturdy and dishwasher safe. Made of a lined quick-drying fabric originally made for pastry bags, they come in eye-catching patterns with sturdy zippers, and each reusable bag can replace roughly 500 plastic baggies over its usable lifetime. (Dedicated to "a life less plastic," LunchSkins specializes in a wide range of high quality biodegradable and reusable products, from straws to shopping bags, and a portion of each purchase goes to the Oceanic Preservation Society.)
