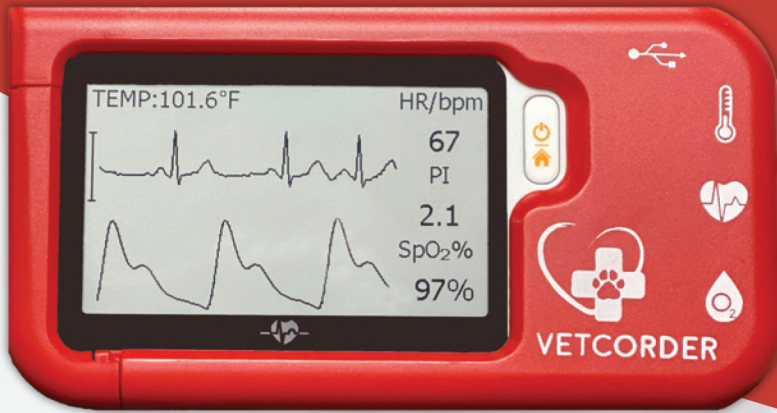

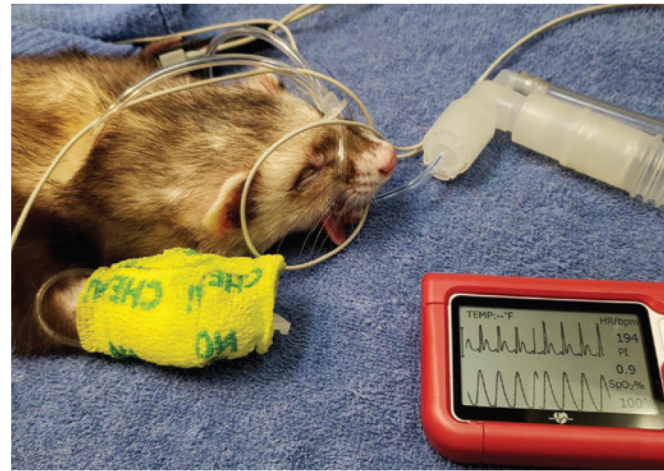

The Case for Vetcorder Pro in Recovery:

According to a recent study, more than half of the deaths tied to veterinary surgery occurred within three hours of recovering from anesthesia, which is used in a multitude of minor procedures.¹

In a 2016 study, 57 percent of dogs and 35.5 percent of cats that underwent procedures using anesthesia experienced an adverse event, including: arousal or breakthrough pain (14.9%), hypoventilation (13.5%), hypotension (10.3%), arrhythmias (5.8%), hyperthermia/hypothermia (5.0%), airway complications (4.8%), recovery excitation (4.6%), aspiration risk (4.5%), desaturation (2.8%), hypertension (1.7%) and other ailments (3.7%).²

The study found that using monitoring tools like Vetcorder Pro can be easily integrated into veterinary practices to provide valuable evidence and data for veterinarians, veterinary technicians and anesthetists to maintain optimal health for their patients during procedures and in recovery.
