


Almost 60 per cent of companies are looking for updated payroll technology

Why it's important?

For years, many companies have endured the high cost of expensive technology platforms adhering to periodic upgrade schedules, and specialised IT resource requirements. Customisations or manual work-around are common because many times needed features and functionality are missing from the solution. As a result, technology costs have been high and product satisfaction has been lacking.

Strategic implications
