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Why Even Fundraise, Anyway?



- It's not just about the money, it's also about the engagement
- Your supporters <u>WANT</u> to help you because they are passionate about your mission and they want to make a difference
- You can build lasting relationships
- You are more visible in the community you serve
- Your supporters are your <u>friends</u>
- You are proving to your funders that you are resourceful and don't depend on only one income source

- You are more sustainable
- You can expand or enhance your projects, or even start a new one

Donor Rights and Our Responsibility



- It's important to treat your supporters the right way. What if you were in their shoes?
 - Make your specific ask. Donors can't help if they don't know how to help or what exactly you need. Don't beat around the bush or be vague.
 - Transparency Financial, governance, reporting
 - Honesty with intentions
 - Respect of donor's personal data and information
 - Confidentiality
 - Use funding in accordance with your donor's wishes
 - Timely response
 - Heartfelt appreciation
 - Share results both positive and negative

Donor Bill of Rights (Opening Statement)

Philanthropy is based on <u>voluntary action</u> for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To assure that philanthropy <u>merits the respect and trust</u> of the general public, and that donors and prospective <u>donors can have full confidence</u> in the not-for-profit organizations and causes they are asked to support, we declare that all donors have these rights:
