CANDLE HISTORY

IN THE BEGINNING

165 BC Hanukkah begins – 8 day celebration involving kindling lights 200 - 400 BC In China candles

In **China** candles were made from whale fat and later bees wax

MIDDLE AGES

Bees Wax introduced as an alternative to **Tallow** – cleaner burning, better smelling, but more expensive

13th Century AD

Candle making becomes a guild craft in Europe. Candle Makers would go door to door making candles from left over kitchen fats or making & selling from small candle shops

500 BC Romans made candles by continually dipping papyrus in tallow or bees wax

200 BC Used in Indian temples, candles were made by boiling cinnamon

1850 Refining waxy substances that that occur in Petroleum, **Paraffin** was cleaner was cleaner and more more economical to produce
