#### **UPCOMING CLASSES**

**Beginning Knitting**---We will start with the basics and go from there. Small class size allows for very individualized attention. \$50—includes instruction leaflet. 4 sessions Monday, February 17, 24, March 2 & 9 9:30-11:30 a.m.

<u>Double Knitting---</u>Learn the basics of reversible two sided knitting! \$35—includes pattern. 3 sessions Sunday, April 19, 26 & May 3 1:00-4:00 p.m. **OR** Monday, April 20, 27 & May 4 1:00-4:00 p.m.

<u>Lacy Business Shawl</u>—This new shawl design is perfect for a "first" shawl project as well as an intro to lace knitting and learning to read a chart! \$40---includes pattern 4 sessions Sunday February 9, 16, 23 & March 1 1:30-4:00 p.m.

<u>Basic 1-Color Brioche</u>—Learn basic brioche stitch. \$20—includes pattern for scarf. 1 session Saturday, March 7 9:30-11:30 a.m. **OR** Monday, March 16 1:30-3:30 p.m.

<u>Basic 2-Color Brioche---</u>Now that you know the basic brioche stitch, let's do it with two colors!! \$20—includes pattern for scarf. 1 session Saturday, March 14 9:30-11:30 a.m. **OR** Monday, March 23 1:30-3:30 p.m.

Brioche in the Round — Make a 2 color cowl while learning to do brioche in the round. MUST KNOW BASIC 2-COLOR BRIOCHE. \$20—includes cowl pattern. 1 session Saturday, March 21 9:30-11:30 a.m. OR Monday, March 30 1:30-3:30 p.m.

Advanced Brioche—Being able to increase and decrease in brioche opens up an entire new world!! MUST KNOW 2-COLOR BRIOCHE. \$30—includes scarf pattern. 2 sessions Saturday, March 28 & April 4 9:30-11:30 a.m. OR Monday, April 6 & 13 1:30-3:30 p.m.

**2-Hand/2-Color Knitting**—Once you learn to knit using **BOTH** hands, two-color knitting is a breeze! The hat pattern we'll be using is sized baby through large adult so you can pick a size that suits your needs! \$30—includes pattern. 2 sessions Sunday, March 15 & 22 1:30 – 3:30 p.m. **OR** Friday, March 20 & 27 1:30-3:30 p.m.

<u>Basic Knit Socks---</u>Learn the basics of sock knitting. Warning: One pair and you will be addicted! \$40---includes pattern. 3 sessions Friday, February 28, March 13 & 27 9:30-11:30 a.m.

<u>2 Socks/2 Circulars</u>—Do you suffer from second sock syndrome? This is the perfect class for you. **MUST KNOW BASIC SOCK CONSTRUCTION.** \$40—includes instruction leaflet. 3 sessions Friday April 3, 17 & May 1 1:00-4:00 p.m.

<u>Knit Sock Heels---</u>Explore numerous different types of heels for your knit socks, including the afterthought heel, strong heel, and more! \$30---includes instructions. 3 sessions Wednesday, April 1, 8 & 15 9:30 a.m. –noon

<u>Open Knitting/Crocheting---</u>Join fellow fiber enthusiasts during this informal gathering time. No registration is required so come when you can! \$1/hour. Wednesdays 1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

Pre-registration is required for all classes except open knitting/crocheting. You can register in person, by mail, e-mail or telephone. Please note that with the number of classes we offer, we generally are not able to re-schedule for missed classes (unless we have to cancel due to sickness or weather). Therefore, we request you check your own schedule carefully before committing to a particular class. We also cannot reschedule or refund for "no shows". Supply lists will be provided at time of registration and we request that any necessary supplies are purchased from Needles 'n Pins.

# Eden's Lacey Scarf Designed by Doreen Marquart

1 skein of Lana Gatto "Eden"

(Sample done in color #8803) entire skein was used for scarf

• US 6 needle

Finished Size: approx. 6" x 92"

Cast on 29 stitches Knit 4 rows. Begin pattern as follows:

Row 1: Slip 1 (as if to purl), knit 1; *yo, k2tog; repeat from* to last stitch, knit 1.

Repeat Row 1 for pattern.

Work until just short of desired length.

Knit 4 rows.

BO loosely. Weave in ends and block!
