## 2022- Customer Agreement Form

Dear Customer,

It is vital to know that any handling of meat must be done according to USDA Regulatory Requirements. Regulation 9CFR 416.4(D) states "Product must be protected from adulteration during processing, handling, storage, loading, unloading and during transportation. Based on information gathered from the Tompkins report, meat transported in unrefrigerated vehicles must reach their destination within 2 hours. If you can meet the above requirements please initial and sign below.

Initial All animals transported to our facility, by you, within the next 12 months have not been treated with antibiotics within 30 days prior to drop off date.
Initial If a scheduled drop off date needs to be rescheduled, you must notify us no later than 1 week prior to the original drop off date.
Initial The USDA/FSIS randomly chooses beef carcasses for sampling. If your product is selected the carcass will be frozen and held until results of the sample testing are received.
Initial All intact and non-intact cuts will be cooked accordingly to ensure a wholesome product.
Initial The tag numbers associated with your animals must be known by establishment for our record keeping and animal traceability. If your animal does not have identification one will be provided.
Initial New England Meat Packing, LLC., is not responsible for any contamination or loss of vacuum seal to the product after it leaves our facility. You are permitted to inspect all items before it is loaded into your mode of transportation.
Initial All Cut sheets must be signed to verify all requested cuts selected by you, the customer.
Initial All payment is due upon product pick-up.
