Headquarters is at the Pavilion near the Hole #1.

General Course Rules

The 2-meter rule is NOT in effect!

1. All paved roads, asphalt, sidewalks* (except where noted on hole-specific rules), parking lots, pavilions, pavements (except tee pads), picnic shelters, amphitheater stage, etc. & playgrounds are OB; The concrete OB line boundaries are defined as the line between the concrete and grass or curb. The “flag lines” are defined by the paint on the ground; flags are for visibility only.
2. On or under any building is OB.
3. All course boundaries and beyond are OB:
 - On the east Spanish Trail Dr.
 - On the north, Arkansas Dr.
 - On the west the fence line to the neighborhood (holes 10, 11, 12)
4. For ALL mandatories, the restricted space (plane) is defined by the inside (safe side) thin vertical/near-vertical line on the tree or pole, and extended upward and opposite infinitely. Any throw which touches or penetrates the restricted space while in flight in any direction, has missed the mando as per PDGA rule 804.01.
5. White Tees are the standard concrete tee boxes, and are the shorter tee marked on the map.
6. Gold (Championship) Tees will be played on Sunday only for MA1 and MA40 divisions as follows:
 - In round 2 for holes # 1, 2, 8, 12, 13, 14, 17, and 18.
 - The championship tees are the longer tee marked on the map; the harder to locate ones are noted with the gold number in the black box.
7. For any division with a first place tie after the final round, competitors need to report to HQ immediately following the conclusion of the round. The tournament official will conduct a coin toss or other random assignment method to determine throwing order for the first playoff hole. Playoff holes for MA1 and MA40 are **1, 3, 8, & 18**; other divisions will play 1, 3, 5, 7 in a loop. Playoff format is sudden death (no scoring).

Specific hole rules, Basket Position distances, Layout, Out-of-Bounds, and Special Conditions:

1. White Tee – B 565' Gold Tee – B 594' (rd.2 MA1 & MA40)
OB on or left of Sidewalk, Parking Lot, and Paved Driveway; OB on or beyond curb and road (deep).
OB right or beyond Hole 3's OB.
2. White Tee – B 334' Gold Tee – B 670' (rd.2 MA1 & MA40)
None.
3. B 397' (rd. 1) C 520' (rd. 2)
OB left of Flag Line surrounding woods, dirt mounds, and chip stacks. OB right or beyond Hole 1's OB.

Note: the sidewalk by the practice basket (sidewalk to nowhere) is NOT OB; the pavement that is surrounding the pavilion is the OB.

In basket position C, the **Flag Line left** extends forward indefinitely. The basket and green (marked) is IB and is **completely surrounded by OB** (aka, an "island" green). Any throw that comes to rest and is **OB short** of the imaginary line through the B-pin (see caddy book) **must** throw from either the OB spot (up to one-meter from) or the previous lie with a one-throw penalty.

Special conditions: There is a Drop Zone at the entry way (on the left) to the "island" green, with OB between the DZ and "island." Any throw that **comes to rest & is OB** on or beyond the imaginary line through the B-pin (see caddy book) **must** next throw from the drop zone with a one-throw penalty or re-throw from the previous lie with a one-throw penalty.

8. White Tee – B 395' Gold Tee – B 750' (rd.2 MA1 & MA40)
OB on or right of sidewalk.

From the Gold Tee **only**, these special *conditions* apply:

a) **OB** in or short of the curvy creek that runs through the woods (see caddy book); **OB** for a disc declared lost.

b) Following the tee throw the next throw may be from the succeeding lie, or from **the optional drop zone** (white tee) **with a one-throw penalty, whether IB or OB**. A player may elect to begin **from the drop zone throwing three** and not throwing from the Gold Tee.

c) If the tee throw comes to rest on or right of the sidewalk and beyond the OB creek line, it is NOT OB; the player may continue playing from that lie without penalty. On any succeeding throws, once a player's throw crosses to the left of the sidewalk, then **on or right of the sidewalk becomes OB**.

9. B 259'
OB - None. The water and creek behind the basket is casual. Relief AWAY from the basket along the line of play is available.
10. B 291'
OB left of Course Boundary Fence (property line). ***Do not go across the property line to retrieve a disc, nor for any other purpose.***
OB on or beyond sidewalk (deep).

White → B 564' Par 4

SUN: (MA1 & MA40 only):

Gold → B 594' Par 4

OB on or left of Sidewalk,
Parking Lot, and Paved
Driveway;

OB on or beyond road and
curb (deep).

OB right or beyond Hole 3's
OB flag line.



HOLE 2

White → B 334' Par 3

SUN: (MA1 & MA40 only):

Gold → B 670' Par 4

OB -- None.

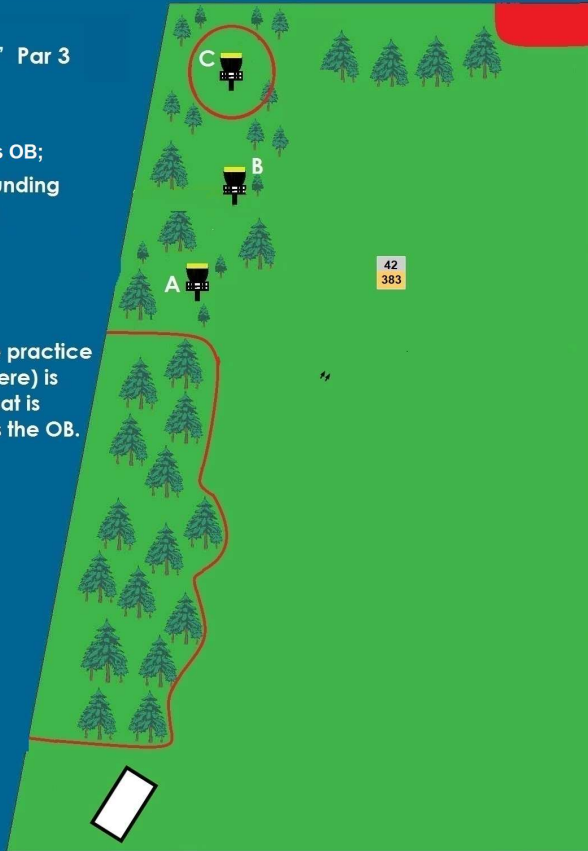


HOLE 3B

SAT : White → B 397' Par 3

OB right or beyond hole 1's OB;
OB left of Flag Line surrounding woods, dirt mounds, and chip stacks.

Note: the sidewalk by the practice basket (sidewalk to nowhere) is NOT OB; the pavement that is surrounding the pavilion is the OB.



HOLE 3C

SUN: White → C 520' Par 4

OB right or beyond hole 1's OB;
OB left of Flag Line surrounding woods, dirt mounds, and chip stacks.

In basket position C, the Flag Line left extends forward indefinitely. The basket and green (marked) is IB and is completely surrounded by OB (aka, an "island" green). Any throw coming to rest OB left short of the imaginary line (in yellow) through the B-pin

must next throw from either the OB spot or the previous lie with a one-throw penalty.

Special Conditions (in basket position C):

There is a drop zone (marked) at the entry way to the "island" green, with marked OB between the DZ and "island." Any throw that comes to rest OB on or beyond the imaginary line through the B-pin must next throw from the drop zone or previous lie with a one-throw penalty.

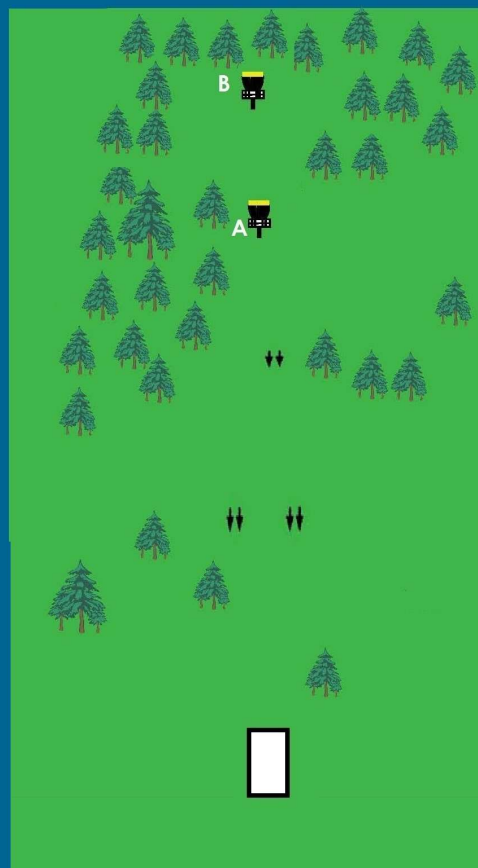

OB on or right of sidewalk.

SUN: MA1 & MA40 only

Gold → B 750' Par 4

From the Gold Tee only, these special conditions apply:

- OB in or short of the casual creek that carves through the woods, or OB for a disc declared lost.
- Following the tee throw the next throw may be from the succeeding lie, or from the optional drop zone (white tee) with a one-throw penalty (whether OB or IB). A player may elect to begin from the drop zone throwing three and not throwing from the Gold Tee.
- If the tee throw comes to rest on or right of the sidewalk past the OB creek line, it is NOT OB; the player may continue playing from that lie without penalty. On any succeeding throws, once a player's throw crosses to the left of the sidewalk, then on or right of the sidewalk becomes OB.



HOLE 9

BOTH DAYS: White → C 259 Par 3

OB -- None.

NOTE: The creek behind the basket and all water are all casual.



HOLE 10

BOTH DAYS:

White → B 291' Par 3

OB left of Course Boundary Fence (property line).
Do not go across the property line to retrieve a disc, nor for any other purpose.

OB on or beyond sidewalk (deep).



HOLE 11

BOTH DAYS:

White → B 300' Par 3

OB on or left of Sidewalk.



HOLE 12

White → B 557' Par 3

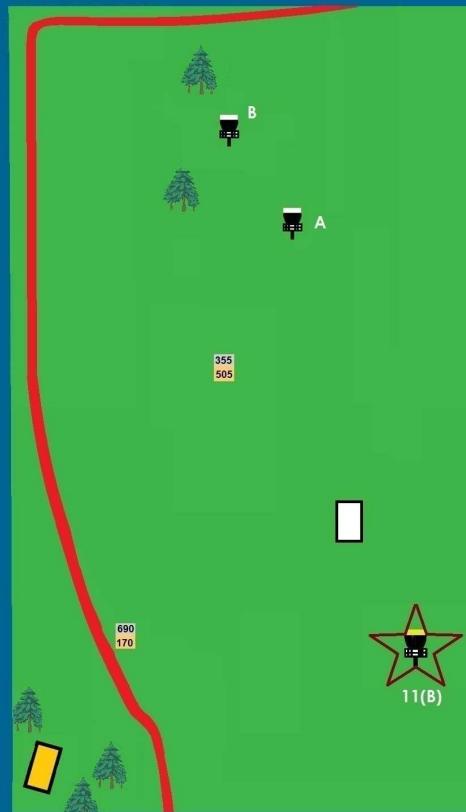
SUN: (MA1 & MA40 only)

Gold → B 860' Par 4

OB on or left of Sidewalk.

OB on or beyond sidewalk
(deep).

From the Gold Tee, the tee box
itself is IB and is completely
surrounded by OB. Tee throws
must cross the sidewalk to be
inbounds.

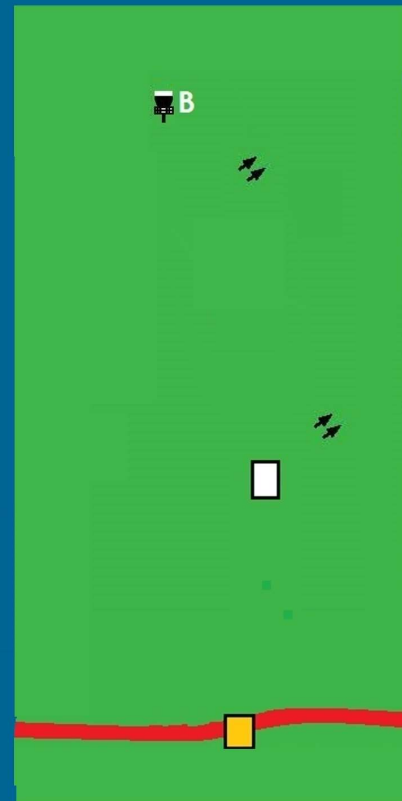


HOLE 13

White → B 373' Par 3

Missed mando next throws from the marked drop zone with a one-throw penalty.

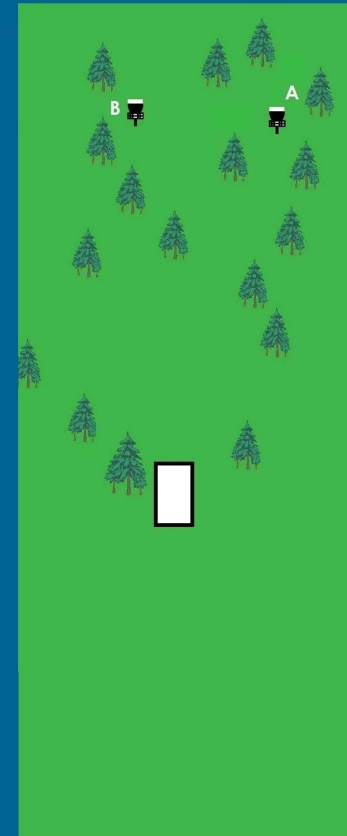


HOLE 15

White → B 275' Par 3

OB on or right of sidewalk (bordering hole 8's/10's fairway (across the trees).



HOLE 17

White → B 429' Par 3

SUN: (MA1 & MA40 only)
Gold → B 625' Par 4

OB on or right of sidewalk (bordering hole 8's fairway across the trees)

OB on or beyond sidewalk (deep) past basket.

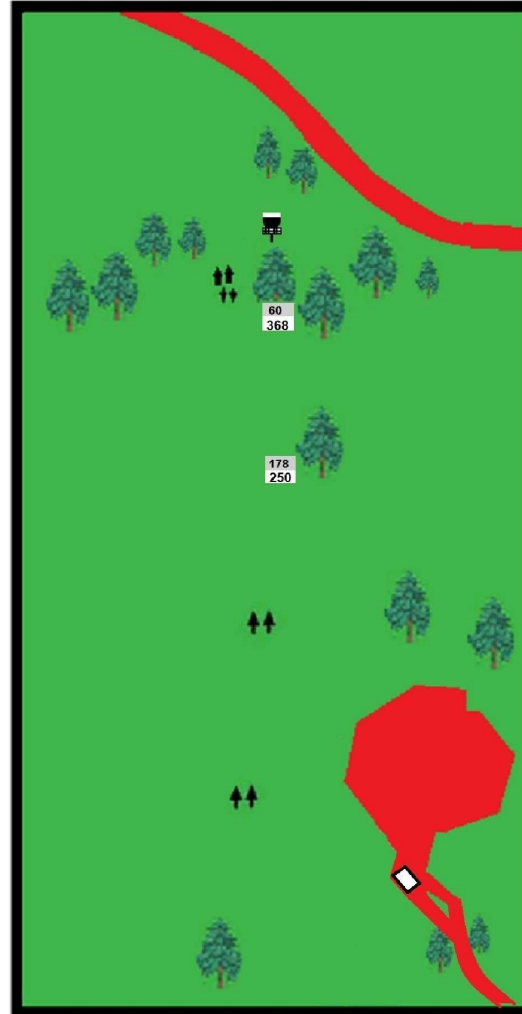


HOLE D 428' Par 3

SUNDAY ONLY

AFTER HOLE 17

Play holes D, E, & F between holes 17 & 18. To get to hole D facing 17's basket, turn back and to your left (over your left shoulder) toward the amphitheater band-shell. Hole D's tee is left of the amphitheater band-shell and on the sidewalk. Hole D plays in front of the amphitheater band-shell.



Tee off from marked area on sidewalk, stage left of amphitheater.

OB on or beyond or right of sidewalk.

The outer OB line (of the amphitheater) is the dividing edge between the grass and the pavement surrounding the band-shell, including the culvert concrete.

HOLE E

522' Par 4



OB completely surrounded by water or landing in water and not found.

OB on or beyond parking lot left.

OB on or beyond the curvy sidewalk left.

OB on or beyond road (right).

OB on or beyond driveway to parking lot (deep).

OB inside the marked tree planters near the basket.

The three small brick planters (in pink) each have a penalty-free drop spot if any part of your disc's position or lie is touching. Please do not throw from those planters. Lies within one meter may also utilize the penalty-free spot.

Special Condition:

There is an optional Drop Zone for ANY throw coming to rest OB.

Standard OB rules apply throughout this hole, meaning the OB player may elect the OB spot, previous lie, or drop zone as they so choose.

A player may elect to begin from the drop zone throwing three and not throwing from the tee.

NOTE:

The concrete drainage extension from the parking lot is safe.

HOLE F

330' Par 3

To Hole 18



OB on or right of sidewalk.

OB on or right of pavilion.

There is a mando (stay left) of the US Flag pole at the Vets monument.

A missed mando next throws from the marked drop zone with a one-throw penalty.

AFTER HOLE F

After hole F, turn to your left and Hole 18's tees (both white and gold) are past the tee for hole D and basket 17.

HOLE 18

FRI:

White → C 368' Par 3

SAT - SUN:

Gold → C 538' Par 4

OB on or left of sidewalk, parking lot, bridge, and marked botanical garden.

OB left of marked rock line.

OB on or beyond the sidewalk (deep) past basket position C.
