10. B 291'

OB left of Course Boundary Fence (property line). \*\*\*Do not go across the property line to retrieve a disc, nor for any other purpose.\*\*\* OB on or beyond sidewalk (deep).

- 11. White Tee B 300' OB on or left of Sidewalk.
- 12. White Tee B 557' Gold Tee B 860' (rd.2 and 3)
  OB on or left of sidewalk. OB on or beyond sidewalk (deep).
  From the Gold Tee, the tee box itself is inbounds and is completely surrounded by OB. Tee throws must cross the sidewalk to be inbounds.
- 13. White Tee B 373' OB – None.

Gold Tee – B 613' (rd.2 and 3)

- 14. White Tee B 479' (rd.1) Gold Tee B 679' (rd.2 and 3)
  From the Gold Tee there is a mando tree (stay right) on left corner of the tree line. A player missing the mando next throws from the marked drop zone with a one-throw penalty.
- 15. White Tee A 206 (rd.1) B 226 (rd.2 and 3) OB on or beyond sidewalk (deep of basket, past 11's tee pad).
- 16. White Tee B 275' (all three rounds) OB on or right of sidewalk (bordering hole 8's & 10's fairway across the trees to the right)
- **17.** White Tee B 429' (rd.1) Gold Tee B 625' (rd.2 and 3) OB on or right of sidewalk (bordering hole 8's fairway across the trees), OB beyond the sidewalk (deep). **NOTE:** There is no mando on hole 17.
  - D. Temp Hole 428' After hole 17, turn toward the amphitheater and left. Next is hole D and the tee for hole D is stage left of the amphitheater band-shell on the sidewalk.
     OB on or right of (beyond) sidewalk, OB on amphitheater pavement or beyond, including the concrete from the culvert lining the amphitheater.
  - E. Temp Hole 522' Tee off at the south end of the dam.
    OB completely surrounded by water or OB for a disc declared lost, OB on or beyond curvy sidewalk left, OB on or beyond parking lot left, OB on or beyond driveway (deep), OB on or beyond road right. OB inside the marked tree planters near the basket.
    Special Conditions: There is an *optional* Drop Zone for <u>any</u> throw coming to rest OB; standard OB rules apply with player able to choose previous lie, OB spot, or drop zone with a one-throw penalty. The bricked-in planter areas by the benches are casual relief areas, each with a marked, <u>penalty-free</u> relief spot. Safe throws within 1 meter of these areas may also use the penalty-free relief spot. Players may also elect to start from the drop zone throwing three and not teeing from the south end of the dam.
  - F. Temp Hole 330' Tee is left of E's basket past Veterans' monument. OB on or right of sidewalk, OB on or right of pavilion. There is a mando (stay left) at the US flag pole near monument. NOTE: Any throw in flight or coming to rest that touches, crosses, or penetrates the missed mando line (restricted space) in ANY direction is an OB for missed mando. A missed mando next throws from the marked drop zone with a one-throw penalty.

18. White Tee - C 368' Gold Tee - C 538' (rd.2 and 3)
 OB on or left of Sidewalk, Parking Lot, Bridge, and marked Botanical Garden; OB left of marked rock line.
 OB on or beyond the Sidewalk (deep).

## **General Course Rules**

## The 2-meter rule is NOT in effect!

- 1. All paved roads, asphalt, sidewalks\* (except where noted on hole-specific rules), parking lots, pavilions, pavements (except tee pads), picnic shelters, amphitheater stage, etc. & playgrounds are OB; The concrete OB line boundaries are defined as the <u>line</u> between the concrete and grass or curb. The "flag lines" are defined by the paint on the ground; flags are for visibility only.
- 2. On or under any building is OB.
- 3. All course boundaries and beyond are OB:
  - On the east Spanish Trail Dr.
  - On the north, Arkansas Dr.
  - On the west the fence line to the neighborhood (holes 10, 11, 12)
- 4. For ALL mandatories, the restricted space (plane) is defined by the inside (safe side) thin vertical/near-vertical line on the tree or pole, and extended upward and opposite infinitely. Any throw which touches or penetrates the restricted space while in flight in <u>any</u> direction, has missed the mando as per PDGA rule 804.01.
- 5. White Tees are the standard concrete tee boxes, and are the shorter tee marked on the map.
  - Gold (Championship) Tees will be played on Saturday and Sunday as follows:
  - In rounds 2 and 3 for holes # 1, 2, 8, 12, 13, 14, 17, and 18.
  - The championship tees are the longer tee marked on the map; the harder to locate ones are noted with the gold number in the black box.
- For any division with a first place tie after the final round, competitors need to report to HQ immediately following the conclusion of the round. The tournament official will conduct a coin toss or other random assignment method to determine throwing order for the first playoff hole. Playoff holes are 1, 3, 8, & 18; in a loop. Playoff format is sudden death (no scoring).

\* except where noted on hole-specific rules.

Specific hole rules, Basket Position distances, Layout, Out-of-Bounds, and Special Conditions:

- NOTE: Any playoff for first in any division will begin immediately following the final grouping completing the round and all scores verified at HQ (see course TD). Playoffs are sudden death beginning at Hole 1 (gold) and continuing to #3(to C-pin), #8 (gold) and #18 (gold), and repeating, until the first hole where a winner is determined.
- White Tee B 565' (rd. 1) Gold Tee B 594' (rd.2 and 3) OB on or left of Sidewalk, Parking Lot, and Paved Driveway; OB on or beyond curb and road (deep). OB right or beyond flag line separating the fairways for holes 1 &3.
- 2. White Tee B 334' (rd. 1) Gold Tee B 670' (rd.2 and 3) None.
- 3. B 397' (rd. 1) C 520' (rd.2 and 3)

OB left of Flag Line surrounding woods, dirt mounds, and chip stacks. OB right or beyond flag line separating the fairways for holes 1 &3.

**Note: the sidewalk by the practice basket (sidewalk to nowhere) is** <u>NOT</u> **OB;** the pavement that is surrounding the pavilion is the OB.

In basket position C, the Flag Line left extends forward indefinitely. The basket and green (marked) is IB and is completely surrounded by OB (*aka*, an "island" green). Any throw that comes to rest and is OB <u>short</u> of the imaginary line through the B-pin (see caddy book) <u>must</u> throw from either the OB spot (up to one-meter from) or the previous lie with a one-throw penalty.

Special conditions: There is a Drop Zone at the entry way (on the left) to the "island" green, with OB between the DZ and "island." Any throw that comes to rest & is OB on or beyond the imaginary line through the B-pin (see caddy book) <u>must</u> next throw from the drop zone with a one-throw penalty or re-throw from the previous lie with a one-throw penalty.

- 4. B 239' None.
- 5. White Tee B 349'
- None.
- 6. B 329′ (rd. 1) C 379 (rd.2 and 3) None.
- 7. B 360' (rd.1) C 390' (rd.2 and 3) None.
- 8. White Tee B 395' OB on or right of sidewalk.

Gold Tee - B 750' (rd.2 and 3)

From the Gold Tee **only**, these special *conditions* apply:

a) OB short of the woods tree line; OB for a disc declared lost.

b) Following the tee throw the next throw may be from the succeeding lie, or from the *optional* drop zone (white tee) with a one-throw penalty, *whether IB or OB*. A player may elect to begin from the drop zone throwing three and not throwing from the Gold Tee.
c) If the tee throw comes to rest on or right of the sidewalk and beyond the OB creek line, it is <u>NOT</u> OB; the player may continue playing from that lie without penalty. On any succeeding throws, once a player's throw crosses to the left of the sidewalk, then on or right of the sidewalk becomes OB.

9. B 259'

OB - None. The water and creek behind the basket is casual. Relief AWAY from the basket along the line of play is available.
