

Product Care and Maintenance Before Use

GOGGLES & LENSES

- Visually inspect goggle lenses in order to detect dirt, scratches, or damaged components.
- If components are damaged or the lens is badly scratched, you will need to purchase a replacement lens or new goggles.
- Wash the microfiber bag regularly to avoid the build-up of residual dirt and dust that can scratch or stain the lens.
- In case of dirt or spots on the lens, use water and/or mild soap to clean the lens before use; never use cleaning solutions. Use only the microfiber bag included with your goggles to clean the lens. Do not use paper products, ski gloves, or other abrasive materials to clean the goggle and lens.
- Never place your lenses in an exposed position where they are at risk of falling, as this can lead to scratches.
- Sweat, sunscreen (especially spray-on sunscreen), makeup, and hairspray can ruin lens coatings and cause them to spot and peel if left on the lens for an extended period of time. Gently rinse your lens off with water to remove the residue and use the microfiber bag included with your goggles to clean the lens.
- In order to protect the lens from dust, store the goggles in their microfiber bag or case.
- When not used for extended periods, store the goggles in a dry place.
- Do not leave goggles in areas of concentrated heat and sunlight, such as on a car dashboard or hanging from a rearview mirror.

Disclaimer

Dirt, dust, and/or wiping on the lens surface, and/or using a non-compliant cloth/tissue (or any combination of these) may cause permanent damage to the lens surface that will not be covered by the warranty.

Inner Lens Antifog Recovery Procedure

Issue: Lens Fogging

Always dry out your goggles in the open and at room temperature after each day of use. If it was especially wet that day, we recommend you remove the lenses (see How Do I Replace My Lenses) and allow them to dry independently of the frames. This allows you to completely dry every piece of the goggles.

If you have ongoing issues with fogging, please follow this procedure:

- 1. Gather up the following materials: measuring cup, teaspoon, dishwasher detergent, and your goggle bag.
- 2. Mix 1 teaspoon (5ml) of the dishwashing detergent with 1 & 1/4 cup of water (300ml).
- 3. Take a soft cloth or your SHRED goggle bag and dip it in the detergent mix.
- 4. Gently wipe the area with water spots.
- 5. Run the same cloth or goggle bag under clean water.
- 6. Wipe off the lens a few times.
- 7. Let the lens dry out in the open for 40 minutes.
