Bible Study Guide for II & III John

Day 1 - Overview

1. II and III John differ from I John in that they are personal letters to individuals. They do not introduce new truths but re-emphasize the truths and attitudes already established in I John. There is some question as to whom the "chosen lady" refers. Some believe that she is a cryptic designation for a church and its members. Others feel that she was a very special woman in the early church, who, along with her children, were devoted to Christ. She had probably been a blessing and help to John in his work. Read all of II and III John looking for themes and repeated words. Record your observations.
