## Bible Study Guide for I Thessalonians 1:1-10

## Day 1 - Acts 17:1-15

- 1. To better understand Paul's connection and concern for the church at Thessalonica, read **Acts 17:1-15**. Examine this account carefully and answer the questions below.
  - a. What does **Acts 17:2 & 3** tell you about Paul and his ministry? (Paul and Silas had just come from Philippi where they had been thrown into prison for their work and testimony for the gospel.)
  - b. The last of **17:2** states that Paul "reasoned with them from the Scriptures." What Scriptures would have been used in the synagogue?
  - c. What was the strong message that Paul taught? 17:3
  - d. From 17:4 who responded positively to Paul's message?
- 2. What was the heart response of the rest of the Jewish community as seen in 17:5?
- 3. Read **Acts 17:5-15** and briefly give an account of the Jews actions both in Thessalonica and in Berea.
- 4. Paul and Silas had stirred up the city of Thessalonica. Review **17:2** to see how many times Paul preached in the city?
- 5. Have you experienced ridicule when you stood for the truth of the gospel? What does this account teach you about boldness and tenacity when we are ridiculed?
