Serious kiwi outdoor folk want a good solid wide-fitting boot that will take a few hits and last the test of time. They are not worried that it doesn't have a design award in footwear or incorporates the latest trendy colours, all they are worried about is that it is comfortable and will do the job they require of it.

The Lowa Tibet GTX boot is one boot that has continued to remain relatively unchanged over the past ten or so years and there is a very good reason for it - it is a great boot and there's nothing wrong with the way it is!

This boot sits at the top of our footwear wall display not for the reason that it is one of the most expensive we sell, but for the fact that it continues to perform, doing the job year in and year out. We see customers returning to buy another pair as they were happy with the way their initial pair went.

When it comes to features, the Tibet GTX ticks every box, Gore-Tex® lined, Vibram sole, stiff flex footbed, high protective rand one piece 2.4m leather upper, flex fit and the Lowa balance custom insole.

It is a serious high country hard wearing boot that gives plenty of ankle support and stiffness for sidling and digging your toes in on the really steep stuff. For those keen alpine hunters, they are also flexible crampon compatible. Being slightly higher in the ankle than most other boots in its class, the Tibet GTX provides the extra support you need in places like Fiordland and the Southern Alps.

As with all good boots, they require the correct care and attention if you want them to last. Lowa produce an active cream that keeps the leather supple, stopping it from drying out and cracking. The use of this will certainly prolong the life of your boots. The genuine Gor-Tex® lining keeps the boot waterproof while still letting it breathe which works well in all four seasons.

The Lowa Tibet GTX WXL needs no test fire from me, as I wear them and rate them highly. The test has been how they have stood up to extreme kiwi conditions for the past ten years and remain our number one selling boot.
