Ring Size Guide
Ideally fingers should be sized properly by a profesional jeweller using a ring sizer.
If this is not possible then the following may be used to estimate your size.
To measure your ring size, please print out this guide and be sure it is printed in A 4 size and scaled to $100 \%$. To make sure it is printed correctly, position a credit card on the line below or place the correct coin in one of the labeled ring sizes. If the card or coin lines up, you're good to go!

Match Your Ring
To find your ring size, use an existing ring that you wear on the finger you would like to measure and that fits you well. Match the inside of that ring with one of the circles below. When your ring has been placed on the right size, you should see only the white circle-with no black space-inside your ring. If your ideal fit falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.


## Use a String or Paper

Ideally fingers should be sized properly by a profesional jeweller using a ring sizer.
If this is not possible then the following may be used to estimate your size.

Please note, that the below directions will give an approximate guide to establish your ring size.

## 1.

Use a piece of string or paper no wider than 1.4 cm ( $1 / 2$ inch) You can also print out this page and cut out the ruler provided below. To make sure it is printed correctly, position a credit card on the line below.

If the card lines up, you're good to go!

## 2.

Take the string / paper and wrap it around the base of your finger.

## 3.

With a Pen or marker, mark where the string / paper first overlaps.

## 4.

Then, line that up with a ruler and take down its length in millimeters.

TIPS: To ensure the ring fits comfortably, we suggest measuring your knuckle as well. We recommend selecting a size that will slide on and off your finger easily The string or paper must fit snugly to produce an accurate size. Finger size can change depending on the time of day and weather; for the most accurate measurement, measure your finger at different times of the day, and on different days to compare. Avoid measuring your fingers when they are cold or wet, as they will be at their smallest.
