

Yardages and Cutting

Note: WOF is width of fabric from selvage to selvage

Season's Greetings 2 1/2"-Strip Snack Pack 314-SG14

- From each of 12 red strips and 12 green strips,
 1 set of the following pieces:
 (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle, (1) 2 1/2" square and (3) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- From the white holly leaf print strips and the white poinsettia print strips, (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- From 1 light strip, (18) 2" squares (borders)
- From 1 light strip, (4) 2" squares (border corners)
- From remainder of all strips, (12) 2" x 8" and (10) 2" x 7 1/2" rectangles (borders)

5/8 yard Green snowflake print, 103-41716

• 6 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding

2 1/4 yards White solid, 160-9800

- 3 strips 4 1/2" x WOF; cut into (24) 4 1/2" squares
- 11 strips 2 1/2" x WOF; cut into (24) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles and (120) 2 1/2" squares
- 10 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for borders

3 1/4 yards Backing of choice

• 2 pieces 55" long

Piecing the Blocks

Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching.

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 1/2" white, red and green squares.
- 2. Place a marked white square right sides together on 1 end of a red 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle. Stitch on the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press the white corner to the right side. Repeat on the remaining end of the rectangle to complete 1 red A unit. Repeat with each red 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle to make 12 red A units total. Repeat with each green 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle to make 12 green A units total.







3. Repeat step 2 with a marked red square on 1 corner of 12 white 4 1/2" squares to make 12 red B units. Repeat with a marked green square on 1 corner of the remaining white 4 1/2" squares to make 12 green B units.



4. Repeat step 2 with marked white squares on 1 end of 6 red 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles to make 6 red C units. Repeat on the opposite end of the remaining red 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles to make 6 red reversed CR units. Repeat with the green 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles to make 6 green C units and 6 green reversed CR units.





5. Repeat step 2 with marked white squares on each end of the white poinsettia print 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles to make 12 D units. Repeat with the white holly print rectangles to make 12 E units.




- 6. To piece 1 Block 1, select 1 of each same-red A, B and C units and (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles; 1 of each same-green A, B and C units and (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles; 1 D unit and 1 E unit; and 2 white 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
- 7. Sew a red 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to opposite sides of the green B unit and add the red A unit to 1 long side. Press seams toward the rectangles and then the A unit to complete the 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" red wreath section. Repeat with the green A unit, green rectangles and the red B unit to make the green wreath section.






8. Sew a white 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle between the D unit and the green C unit to make the 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" top corner. Press seams toward the white rectangle. Repeat with the E unit, red C unit and remaining white rectangle to make the bottom corner.

- 9. Stitch the top corner to the red wreath section to make the top row. Press seam toward the wreath section. Repeat with the bottom corner and the green wreath section to make the bottom row. Join the rows to complete (1) 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" Block 1. Press seams to the green wreath side. Repeat to make 4 blocks total.
- 10. Repeat steps 6–9 to make 2 Block 2, paying careful attention to placement of the green and red wreath sections and the D and E units in the blocks.
- 11. Repeat steps 6–9 to make 4 Reversed Block 1, using red and green CR units and paying careful attention to the placement of the green and red wreath sections and the D and E units in the blocks. (see diagrams on next page)
- 12. Repeat steps 6–9 to make 2 Reversed Block 2, using red and green CR units and paying careful attention to the placement of the green and red wreath sections and the D and E units in the blocks. (see diagrams on next page)








Block 1 — Make 4

Block 2 — Make 2










Reversed Block 1 — Make 4

Completing the Quilt

Refer to the Exploded Quilt Diagram on the next page throughout the following steps.

- 1. Sew a Block 2 between 2 Block 1's to make row 1. Press seams toward Block 2. Repeat to make row 3.
- 2. Stitch a Reversed Block 2 between 2 Reversed Block 1's to make row 2. Press seams away from Reversed Block 2. Repeat to make row 4.
 - 3. Sew the rows together to complete the 36 1/2" x 48 1/2" quilt center. Press seams to 1 side.
- 4. Stitch the 2 1/2" x WOF white solid strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) 48 1/2" strips, (2) 40 1/2" strips, (2) 55 1/2" strips and (2) 47 1/2" strips. Sew the 48 1/2" strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the 40 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips. Set aside the remaining strips for the outer border.
- 5. Sew 5 light 2" border squares alternately together with 6 assorted 2" x 8" border rectangles. Press seams toward the rectangles. Trim 1/2" off each end to make a 2" x 52 1/2" side border strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Stitch the strips to the long sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the strips.
- 6. Stitch 4 light 2" border squares alternately together with 5 assorted 2" x 7 1/2" border rectangles. Press seams toward the rectangles. Trim 1/2" off each end to make a 2" x 40 1/2" strip. Sew a light 2" border corner square to each end to make the top border strip. Press seams away from the corner squares. Repeat to make the bottom border strip. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams toward the strips.
- 7. Sew the 2 1/2" x 55 1/2" white strips from step 4 to the long sides of the quilt center and the 2 1/2" x 47 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips to complete the quilt top.
- 8. Join the 2 backing pieces on the long sides with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim the top and bottom edges to make the 55" x 67" backing.
- 9. Layer, quilt, and bind using your favorite methods and the green snowflake binding strips to complete the quilt.
