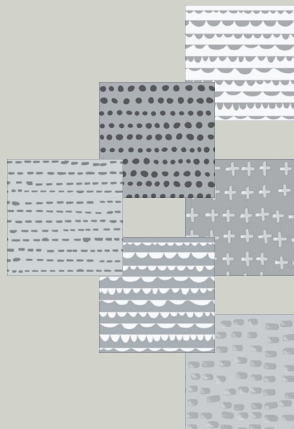

GETTING STARTED

Read the instructions in this pattern completely before beginning. Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Width of fabric (WOF) is assumed to be 40". Share your piecing progress and quilt on Instagram with #crosswalksquilt and #quiltachusetts hashtags.

BLOCK 1 CUTTING

From Dots Reverse fabric, cut:

- 5 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF, subcut
40 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

From Festoons fabric, cut:

- 3 @ $4\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF, subcut
20 @ $4\frac{5}{8}$ " x $4\frac{5}{8}$ "

From Boxes Reverse fabric, cut:

- 5 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF, subcut
40 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

From Raspberry fabric, cut:

- 1 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

From Codes Reverse fabric, cut:

- 2 @ 5" x WOF, subcut
10 @ 5" x 5"
- 3 @ $4\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF, subcut
20 @ $4\frac{5}{8}$ " x $4\frac{5}{8}$ "

From Orange fabric, cut:

- 3 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

From Green fabric, cut:

- 4 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

From Dashes fabric, cut:

- 3 @ $4\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF, subcut
20 @ $4\frac{5}{8}$ " x $4\frac{5}{8}$ "

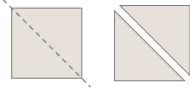
From Medium Blue fabric, cut:

- 2 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "



BLOCK 1 CONSTRUCTION

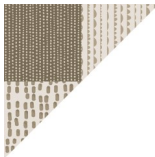
1. Cut the 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ " squares in half diagonally.



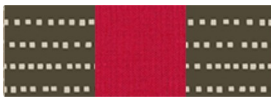
2. Sew a dashes triangle to the right side of a dots reverse 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square and a festoons triangle to the bottom as shown for a triangle unit. Sew 20.



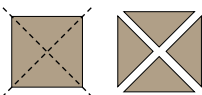
3. Sew a festoons triangle to the right side of a dots reverse 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square and a dashes triangle to the bottom as shown for a triangle unit. Sew 20.



4. Sew each raspberry, orange, green and medium blue square between 2 boxes reverse 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.



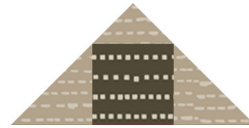
5. Cut the codes reverse 5" squares in half diagonally twice.



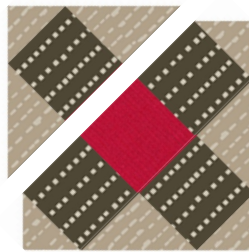
6. Sew a triangle from step 5 to both ends of the 3 square units.



7. Sew 2 codes reverse 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ " triangles to the sides of the remaining boxes reverse squares and 1 codes reverse 5" triangle to the top. Sew 20.

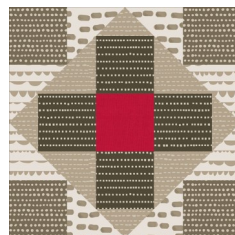


8. Sew a step 6 unit between 2 step 7 units for a center unit. Sew 10.



9. Sew a step 2 triangle unit to the top left and bottom right of a center unit.

10. Sew a step 3 triangle unit to the top right and bottom left to complete a 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " block 1. Sew 10.



BLOCK 2 CUTTING

From Codes fabric, cut:

- 2 @ 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF, subcut
- 10 @ 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ "

From Boxes fabric, cut:

- 2 @ 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF, subcut
- 10 @ 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ "

From Dashes Reverse fabric, cut:

- 7 @ 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF

From Pluses Reverse fabric, cut:

- 7 @ 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF

From Dots fabric, cut:

- 7 @ 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF

From Pluses fabric, cut:

- 3 @ 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF, subcut
- 10 @ 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

From Red fabric, cut:

- 2 @ 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

From Yellow fabric, cut:

- 4 @ 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

From Light Blue fabric, cut:

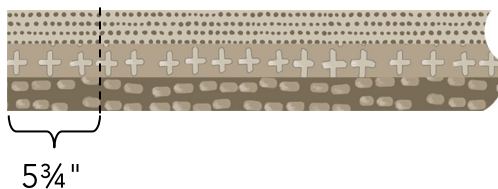
- 3 @ 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

From Burgundy fabric, cut:

- 1 @ 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

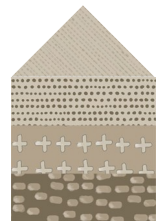
BLOCK 2 CONSTRUCTION

11. Sew a pluses reverse 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strip between a dashes reverse and dots strip lengthwise for a strip set. Sew 7 strip sets.



12. Cut the strips into 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide sections. Cut 40.
13. Cut the codes and boxes 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ " squares in half diagonally.

14. Sew the codes and boxes triangles to the dots end of the step 12 units.



15. Sew two step 14 units with the codes triangles to opposite sides of each red, yellow, light blue and burgundy square.



16. Cut the pluses $8\frac{3}{4}$ " squares in half diagonally twice.
17. Sew 2 pluses triangles to each remaining step 14 unit as shown.



18. Sew 2 step 17 units to the sides of a step 15 unit to complete a $15\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " block 2. Sew 10.



FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

From Binding fabric, cut:

- 8 @ $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

19. Layout the blocks according to the final assembly diagram into 5 rows of 4 blocks each.
20. Sew the blocks into rows and sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.
21. Divide the backing into two 2 yard lengths. Sew panels lengthwise, creating a 72" x 80" backing.
22. Layer backing, batting and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired.
23. Sew $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF binding strips into a continuous piece for straight grain French-fold binding. Bind the quilt.
