Yardages and Cutting

WOF means width of fabric from selvage to selvage for yardage and selvage to cut edge for fat cuts. LOF means length of fabric, parallel to the selvage edges. Remove as little fabric as possible when trimming selvage edges.

1 1/4 yards large floral, 120-99401

• 4 strips 6 1/2" x LOF; trim to (4) 36 1/2" lengths.

1 yard large medallion, 120-99441

- 2 identical strips 6 1/2" x LOF.
- 2 identical strips 6 1/2" x LOF.

1 yard pink print, 120-99481

- 1 strip 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 6 1/2" squares.
- 8 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding.

1/2 yard aqua geometric, 120-99411

• 2 strips 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 6 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles and (2) 6 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.

Fat quarter small floral, 120-99471

• 2 strips 6 1/2" x WOF; trim to (2) 15 1/2" lengths.

Fat quarter green print, 120-99434 Fat quarter stripe print, 120-99451

From each fabric, cut:

• 2 strips 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (4) 6 1/2" squares.

Fat quarter pink packed floral, 120-99421

• 2 strips 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (6) 6 1/2" squares.

Fat eighth agua dots, 120-99461

• 1 strip 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 6 1/2" squares.

2 1/3 yards white solid, Painter's Palette 121-000

- 1 strip 18 1/2" x WOF; cut into 2 each 9 1/2" x 18 1/2", 3 1/2" x 18 1/2", 3 1/2" x 16 1/2", 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" pieces.
- 1 strip 15 1/2" x WOF; cut into 2 each 9 1/2" x 15 1/2" and 3 1/2" x 15 1/2" and (4) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" pieces.
- 6 strips 2 1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 36 1/2" and (4) 27 1/2" lengths and (4) 2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- 1 strip 4 1/2" x WOF; trim to (1) 24 1/2" length.
- 3 strips 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (18) 6 1/2" squares.

4 7/8 yards backing fabric of choice

• 2 pieces 84" x WOF for backing.

Batting

• 1 piece 74" x 84"

Completing the Quilt

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press all seams as directed. Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed throughout the following steps. Refer to the diagrams for the white strip sizes used in each position.

- 1. <u>Side Sections:</u> Referring to the diagram on the next page for the left top unit, sew a white square between pink packed floral and pink print squares. Press seams toward the pink squares. Add a white strip (see diagram for size) to 1 long side of the pieced strip then a white rectangle to the bottom to make a 9 1/2" x 36 1/2" unit. Press seams toward the white pieces. Stitch a large floral strip to the white long edge to complete the 15 1/2" x 36 1/2" top unit. Press seam toward the floral strip.
- 2. Sew green and white squares together. Press seam toward the green square. Repeat with pink packed floral and white squares. Join the 2 pieced strips to make a 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" four-patch unit. Press seam to 1 side. Add a white strip to opposite sides of the four-patch unit. Press seams toward the strips.
- 3. Stitch a small floral rectangle between a white strip and a white rectangle. Press seams toward the floral strip. Sew to the top of the four-patch unit. Press seam toward the four-patch unit. Repeat on the bottom of the four-patch unit with 2 white strips and a 6 1/2" x 15 1/2" aqua geometric rectangle to complete the 15 1/2" x 40 1/2" bottom unit.
- 4. Stitch the top unit to the bottom unit to complete the 15 1/2" x 76 1/2" left section. Press seam toward the bottom section.

5. Repeat steps to make the right section, except turn the units to place the top unit at the bottom of the section and the bottom unit at the top. Pay careful attention to keep large and small florals upright in the finished section.



- 6. **Divider Strips:** Referring to the exploded quilt diagram, sew a stripe print square between 2 white squares. Press seams toward the print square. Repeat to make a second pieced strip.
- 7. Stitch 2 identical large medallion strips short ends together to make a long strip, matching print at the seam. Press seam to 1 side. Trim to 58 1/2". Repeat with the second identical set of strips.
- 8. Sew a pieced strip to the top of 1 large medallion strip and the second pieced strip to the bottom of the remaining large medallion strip to complete (2) 6 1/2" x 76 1/2" divider strips. Press seams toward the large medallion strips.
- 9. Center Section: Stitch pink packed floral and stripe print squares together with 2 white squares to make a four-patch unit. Press seams toward the print squares and the final seam to 1 side. Repeat to make a second fourpatch unit with green print and aqua dots squares. Sew a white strip between the 2 four-patch units. Press seams toward the white strip. Add a white strip to the top. Press seam toward the strip. Stitch a white strip to each long side to complete the 16 1/2" x 27 1/2" pieced unit. Press seams toward the white strips.
- 10. Stitch a 6 1/2" x 16 1/2" aqua geometric rectangle and white strip to the top of the pieced unit. Press seams toward the geometric rectangle. Add a large floral strip and white strip to 1 long side to complete the 24 1/2" x 36 1/2" top unit. Press seams toward the large floral strip.
- 11. Repeat steps to make the bottom unit, except turn the large floral strip to keep it upright in the section referring to the exploded quilt diagram.
- 12. Sew the top and bottom units together with a white strip to complete the 24 1/2" x 76 1/2" center section (see exploded quilt diagram). Press seams toward the white strip.

- 13. Stitch the left, right and center sections together with the 2 divider strips to complete the 66 1/2" x 76 1/2" quilt top. Press seams toward the divider strips.
- 14. Remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make a 74" x 84" backing piece.
 - 15. Layer, quilt, and bind using your favorite methods and the pink print binding strips to complete the quilt.
