

Finished Block Size: 8" x 8"
Finished Quilt Size: 47" x 47"

- Read all instructions prior to beginning.
- WOF = width of fabric.
- Measure twice, cut once.


## FabricS, Чardage \& CuttiNg

* If desired, use a fat quarter pack of the bug fabrics shown with a *instead of yardage.



SKU Yardage Required | Cutting Instructions |
| :---: |

Cut one square ( $\left.6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime \prime}\right)$.

## Additional SUpplies \& Tools

- Backing: 3-1/4 yards pieced to make 55 " $\times 55$ " backing.
- Batting: 55" x 55" piece of batting.
- Coordinating thread.
- Rulers, cutting mat, \& rotary cutter.
- Sewing machine.
- Iron.
- Scissors.


## Piecing the Strips

STEP 1: Sew one strip of Fabric R to one strip of Fabric $S$ along long side. Press seam open.


Repeat to make six sets.

## MAKE STRIP SET A

STEP 2: Sew two sets from STEP 1 together. Press seam open.


Repeat to make two sets.
STEP 3: Cut the pieced strips made in STEP 2 into 1-1/2" wide strips, perpendicular to the seams as shown below.


Cut thirty-two of Strip Set $A$.


## Strip Set A

## MAKE STRIP SET B

STEP 4: Sew one Fabric R strip along remaining long side of Fabric S strip on one of the strip sets made in STEP 1. Press seam open.

STEP 5: Cut the pieced strip made in STEP 4 into 1-1/2" wide strips, perpendicular to the seams as shown below.


Cut sixteen of Strip Set B.


## Strip Set B

## MAKE STRIP SET C

STEP 6: Sew one Fabric S strip along remaining long side of Fabric $R$ strip on the remaining strip set made in STEP 1. Press seam open.


STEP 7: Cut the pieced strips made in STEP 6 into 1-1/2" wide strips, perpendicular to the seams as shown below.


Cut sixteen of Strip Set $C$.


## Strip Set C

## Piecing the BlockS



STEP 8: Sew one Strip Set $B$ to the left side of Fabric A square. Press seam open.

STEP 9: Sew one Strip Set $C$ to the right side of unit made in STEP 8. Pres seam open.


STEP 10: Sew one Strip Set $A$ to the top of unit made in STEP 9. Sew another Strip Set $A$ to the bottom of the unit made in STEP 9. Press seams open.

Repeat STEPS 8-10 to create sixteen blocks using Fabrics B-P for the block centers.

## Piecing the Quilt Top



STEP 11: Sew one sashing strip to the left side of each block. Press seams open.

STEP 12: Piece row of four blocks together. Press seams open.


STEP 13: Sew one sashing strip to the right side of the the pieced row. Press seam open.


Repeat STEPS 11-13 to create remaining three rows.
STEP 14: Sew one cornerstone to the short side of one sashing strip. Press seam open.


STEP 15: Sew four of the units made in STEP 14 and one additional cornerstone together to create a sashing row as shown below. Press seams open.


Repeat to make five sashing rows.
STEP 16: Sew one sashing row to the top of each pieced row. Press seams open.


STEP 17: Sew units from STEP 16 together until you have all four attached to one another. Press seams open.

STEP 18: Sew remaining sashing row to bottom of unit created in STEP 17 to complete quilt center. Press seam open.


STEP 20: Sew borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Press seams open.
STEP 21: Sew borders to top and bottom sides of quilt center. Press seams open.
STEP 22: Layer your quilt sandwich, quilt as desired, and bind to complete your project!
