## CUTTING \& YARDAGE

Directional Fabric - has a definite direction - be aware of this when cutting wof- is width of fabric from selvage to selvage, approx 42"

| 120-13752 yellow <br> Directional | 11/2 | - Cut four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips <br> - Borders - Cut one $26^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof strip <br> Sub cut one $171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 26$ " long piece - Crosscut this section into four $171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall strips <br> - From remaining section, sub cut two $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 211 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall strips |
| 120-13753 blue <br> four-patches | 7/8 | - Cut two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x wof strips <br> - Binding - eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips |
| 120-13751 pink <br> four-patches | 1/3 | - Cut two 3 1/2" x wof strips |
| 120-13741 aqua <br> Directional | 1/2 | - Cut two $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof strips <br> Sub cut into five $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangles |
| 120-13743 peach <br> Directional | 1/2 | - Cut one $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ wof strip <br> Sub cut into three $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangles <br> - From remainder of strip, cut two $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangles |
| 120-13742 blue Directional | 1/2 | - Cut one 12 1/2" x wof strip <br> Sub cut into three $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangles <br> - From remainder of strip, cut two $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangles |


| 120-13731 tan | 1/2 | - Cut two $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips <br> Sub cut into five $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles |

| 120-13732 green <br> cornerstones \& inner border | 2/3 | - Cut one $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof strip <br> Sub cut into four $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares <br> - Cut six strips 2 " x wof - piece on diagonal to make a long strip for inner border |
| Your Choice Backing Batting $71 \times 83$ | 4 3/4 <br> yards | - Backing - Cut two 83" x wof pieces |

Notions: Rulers and mat, rotary cutter. Threads and your favorite notions.

## PIECING THE BLOCKS



1/4" seam allowance used for all piecing

1. Stitch a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ yellow strip to a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue strip to make a strip set. Repeat.

Sub cut into twenty-four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" sections.


Stitch a 3 1/2" pink strip to a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ yellow strip to make a strip set. Repeat.
Sub cut into twenty-four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" sections.

1. Stitch 24 four-patch units as shown.

2. Stitch sections $A$ through $D$ as follows:

Section A uses six four-patch units, one $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangle each aqua and blue hedgehog, one 6 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangle peach hedgehog and one village $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Stitch in rows, then stitch rows into $241 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Section A.


Section B uses two four-patch units, and one village $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. One $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangle each peach and aqua hedgehog, one $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangle blue hedgehog, two $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
rectangles tan paw print, and one village $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
Stitch in rows, then stitch rows into $241 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Section B.


Section C uses ten four-patch units, one peach, one blue and two aqua hedgehog $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangles, one peach and one blue hedgehog $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangles, two $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles tan paw print
and one village 12 1/2" square. Stitch in rows, then stitch rows into $301 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Section C.


Section D uses six four-patch units, one $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangle aqua hedgehog, one each blue and peach hedgehog $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall rectangles, one $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle tan paw print and one village $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Stitch in rows, then stitch rows into 18 1/2" x 36 1/2" Section D.


Section D

Sew Section A to Section B to make the 24 1/2" $\times 48$ 1/2" top row. Stitch Section C to Section D to make the $361 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ bottom row. Join the rows to complete the $481 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quilt center.

##  COMPLETING THE QUILT

It is best practice to measure quilt through several areas, averaging this amount and cutting borders to fit.


1. Horizontal Borders: Use four yellow $171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall strips and two village $171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall strips. Sew a village strip between two yellow strips to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt.
2. Vertical Borders: Use two yellow $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 21$ 1/2" tall strips, four village $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 211 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall strips and four green $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Sew a yellow strip between two village strips and add a green square to each end to make a side border. Repeat. Stitch the borders to the sides of the quilt.
3. Backing: Stitch two lengths along selvedges in a deep seam, about $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, then trim seam to $1 / 4$ " width. Press open. Trim to 71 " x 83".
4. Quilting: Layer backing, batting and top. Quilt with walking foot in diagonal lines or in an all-over meander. Trim all edges even with top.
5.Binding: Stitch 8 strips together in continuous length at short ends on the bias, trim to $1 / 4$ " seam allowance, press open. Fold entire length in half, wrong sides together, press. Leave an excess of twelve inches and starting in the middle of one long side of trimmed quilt, stitch in $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ to $3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Check to be sure quilt will be a snug fit in the binding when it is turned to finish side.
Tip: Pin the binding in place to keep the seam flat and prevent rippling. I prefer to stitch the binding to the quilt back then turning it to the front allowing me to top stitch close to the folded edge in a clean finish.
