

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Fabric **A D G** and **J:** □ Cut **one** 3.5 x 12 inch

☐ Cut **one** 3.5 x 40 inch

Fabric **B C E F H** and **I**: \square Cut **one** 3.5 x 21 inch

☐ Cut **one** 3.5 x 31 inch

WHITE fabric: ☐ Cut two 1.5 inch by WOF

BACKGROUND fabric: ☐ Cut four 1.5 inch by WOF

☐ Cut **one** 3.5 inch x WOF: SUBCUT into **ten** 3.5 x 2.5 inch

rectangles

☐ Cut **two** strips 1.5 inch by WOF: SUBCUT into **forty**

1.5 inch squares

 \square Cut **nine** 4.5 x 40 inch

☐ Cut **five** 4.5 inch x WOF : SUBCUT into **nine** 4.5 x 20 inch

☐ Cut **two** 5.5 x 40 inch

 \square Cut **one** 5.5 inch x WOF : SUBCUT into **two** 5.5 x 20 inch

BINDING fabric: ☐ Cut seven strips 2.25 inches x WOF

BACKING: □ Cut **two** 63 inches x WOF

NOTES

WOF = width of fabric

Seam allowances are 1/4 inch






SEWING DIRECTIONS


AGLETS UNITS

- ☐ Make a strip set by sewing **one** 1.5 inch background strip to either side of a white strip, pressing toward the background strips.
- \square Make **2** in total.
- ☐ Subcut these into **twenty** 3.5 inch units.






☐ Sew a 3.5 x 2.5 inch background rectangle between two strip sets as shown. Press toward the background rectangle.



☐ Make **10** in total.

LACES

☐ Draw a diagonal line on the **wrong side** of all 1.5 inch background squares.







□ STEP 1: Using fabric A and placing right sides together, sew a 1.5 inch background square to the upper right and lower right corners of the 3.5 x 12 inch piece. Sew on the marked lines and trim, leaving a 1/4 inch seam allowance. Press seams open.



□ STEP 2: Sew a 1.5 inch background square to the upper left and lower left corners of the 3.5 x 40 inch piece in the same way, trimming the seam allowance and pressing seams open.





☐ STEP 3: Sew the aglets unit between two fabric A units as shown. Press seams toward fabric A units.



☐ Repeat steps 1-3 using fabric G.

ROWS B, F and H:

- □ Repeat steps 1-3 for making row A, this time using fabric B, F, and H. Sew a 1.5 inch background square to the upper right and lower right corners of each of the 3.5 x 21 inch pieces and to the upper left and lower left corners of each of the 3.5 x 31 inch pieces. Trim and press seams open.
- $\hfill \square$ Join the two lace units of each print with the aglets unit as shown.

| ROWS C, E, and I: |
| □ Repeat steps 1-3 for making row A, this time using fabric C, E, and I. Sew a 1.5 inch background square to the upper right and lower right corners of each of the 3.5 x 31 inch pieces and the upper left and lower left corners of each of the 3.5 x 21 inch pieces. Trim and press. |
| \square Join the two lace units of each print with the aglets unit as shown. |

| ROWS D and J: |
| □ Repeat steps 1-3 for making row A, this time using fabrics D and J. Sew a 1.5 inch background square to the upper right and lower right corner of each of the 3.5 x 40 inch pieces and the upper left and lower left corner of each of the 3.5 x 12 inch pieces. Trim and press. |
| $\hfill \square$ Join the two lace units of each print with an aglets unit as shown. |

| SASHING K ROWS: |
| □ Sew a 4.5 x 20 inch backgroung piece to the RIGHT end of a 4.5 x 40 inch background piece, making a long strip that measures 4.5 x 59.5 inches. |
| ☐ Repeat this three more times, making a total of 4 rows . |
| SASHING L ROWS: |
| ☐ Sew a 4.5 x 20 inch backgroung piece to the LEFT end of a 4.5 x 40 inch background piece, making a long strip that measures 4.5 x 59.5 inch. |

 \square Repeat this four more times, making a **total of 5 rows**.



TOP SASHING:


 \square Sew a 5.5 x 20 inch backgroung piece to the **RIGHT end** of a 5.5 x 40 inch background piece, making a long strip that measures 5.5 x 59.5 inch.

BOTTOM SASHING:

 \square Sew a 5.5 x 20 inch backgroung piece to the **LEFT end** of a 5.5 x 40 inch background piece, making a long strip that measures 5.5 x 59.5 inch.

QUILT ASSEBLY

Layout the rows as shown and sew together to complete the quilt top.





FINISHING:

☐ Remove selvages from one 63 inch edge of each **BACKING** piece.

☐ Align trimmed edges and, with right sides together, sew. Press.

☐ Layer, quilt as desired, and **trim to 59 x 76 inches**.

☐ Make doube-fold binding with 2.25 inch strips of **fabric E** by piecing strips together end to end, and bind using your favorite method.
