

Finished Quilt Size: 59" x 67-1/2"
Finished Block Size: 7" x 10" and 7" x 8"
Number of Blocks: 15 large and 15 small

Yardages and Cutting

WOF means width of fabric from selvage to selvage. Remove as little fabric as possible when trimming selvage edges.

1/3 yard Nutcracker print, 120-19531

• 1 strip 6-1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces. Trim remainder to 4" x 35" and cut into (8) 3-1/2" x 4" pieces

1/3 yard Holly print, 120-19551

• 1 strip 6-1/2" x WOF; cut into (8) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces

1/2 yard Periwinkle Stripe, 120-19581

- 1 strip 6-1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces
- 1 strip 4" x WOF; cut into (12) 3-1/2" x 4" pieces

1/3 yard Tree print, 120-19591

• 1 strip 6-1/2" x WOF; cut into (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces. Trim remainder to 4" x 28" and cut into (8) 3-1/2" x 4" pieces

1/2 yard Teal Diamond, 120-19601

- 1 strip 6-1/2" x WOF; cut into (6) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces
- 1 strip 4" x WOF; cut into (8) 3-1/2" x 4" pieces

1/2 yard Gold Diamond, 120-19603 1/2 yard Pink Diamond, 120-19602

From each fabric, cut:

- 1 strip 6-1/2" x WOF; cut into (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces
- 1 strip 4" x WOF; cut into (12) 3-1/2" x 4" pieces

7/8 yard Red Dot, 120-19612

- 3 strips 3" x WOF; cut into (30) 3" squares
- 9 strips 1-1/2" x WOF; cut (15) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces, (15) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces, and (30) 1-1/2" x 4" pieces

5/8 yard Navy Dot, 120-19611

• 7 strips 2-1/4" x WOF for binding

2-1/2 yards Painter's Palette Solid White, 121-000

- 10 strips 4-1/2" x WOF
- 2 strips 3-1/2" x WOF; cut into (10) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces
- 5 strips 2" x WOF; cut into (25) 2" x 7-1/2" pieces
- 3 strips 3" x WOF; cut into (30) 3" squares
- 3 strips 2-1/2" x WOF; cut into (60) 2" x 2-1/2" pieces

3 7/8 yards backing fabric OR 4 1/3 yards directional backing fabric

- 2 pieces 67" x WOF OR
- 2 pieces 75" x WOF for directional fabric

Batting

1 piece 67" x 75"

Piecing the Blocks

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press all seams toward the prints in blocks.


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" White square. Pair the square right sides together with (1) 3" Red Dots square. Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press HST units open. Square to 2-1/2".




2. Lay out (2) 2" x 2-1/2" White pieces and (2) HST units as shown. Sew the pieces together to create a bow unit. Make a total of (30) bow units.




3. To make a small gift block, sew 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Holly pieces lengthwise to opposite sides of (1) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Red Dot piece. Sew a bow unit to the top to complete the 7-1/2" x 8-1/2" small gift block.




4. In the same way, make the indicated number of small gift blocks shown below, for a total of (15).



5. To make a large gift block, sew 3-1/2" x 4" Yellow Diamond pieces lengthwise to opposite sides of (1) 1-1/2" x 4" Red Dot piece. Make (2) units. Sew the units to both sides of (1) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" Red Dot piece. Sew a bow unit to the top to complete the 7-1/2" x 10-1/2" large gift block.




6. In the same way, make the indicated number of large gift blocks shown below, for a total of (15).



Completing the Quilt


Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram on the next page.

- 1. Lay out (3) small and (3) large gift blocks alternating with (5) 2" x 7-1/2" White pieces. Sew the blocks and pieces into a vertical row. Make a total of (3) rows with small gift blocks at the top and (2) rows with large gift blocks at the top. Sew 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" White pieces to the top and bottom of each row.
- 2. Sew (10) 4-1/2" x WOF White strips short ends together into a long strip. Cut (6) 68" long strips. Sew together the long strips alternating with the vertical block rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram on the next page.
- 3. Remove the selvedge edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make a 67" x 75" backing piece.
- 4. Layer, baste and quilt. Use the (7) 2-1/4" x WOF Navy Dot strips to bind the quilt.
